In Zurich, find yourself marvelling at the historic buildings in the old town, explore the city's landmark: [the Grossmünster church]. Cross the Münsterbrücke bridge and you'll reach the [Fraumünster], with its famous stained glass windows by Marc Chagall. A walk through [Bahnhofstrasse] to [Lake Zurich] will round off your day of sightseeing nicely. Overnight in Fribourg or nearby.

### [Zurich Cathedral]

The Zurich Cathedral is one of the three main churches in Zurich, Switzerland (the other two are the Cathedral of Our Lady of Zurich and St. Peter's Church). The church is located near the banks of the Limmat River. Today's church was built around 1100 and was unveiled around 1220. According to legend, the earliest church was created for Charlemagne. The Zurich Cathedral is a monastery church that competes with the Cathedral of Our Lady of Zurich across the Limmat River in the Middle Ages. Charlemagne's mount stumbled in front of the tombs of the main saints Felix and Regula in Zurich. According to legend, it was earlier than the Cathedral of Our Lady, which was built by the grandson of Charlemagne. Recent archaeological evidence proves that this is the Roman cemetery.

### [Notre Dame Cathedral]

Founded in 853 by Ludwig der Deutsche, the grandson of Charlie the Great, is a Reformed Church. The Cathedral of Our Lady, now standing in Zurich, was rebuilt on the site in the 12th century and is a representative Gothic building. In front of the church, the man riding the horse was Hans Waldman, who had been the mayor of Zurich for many years.

### [Lake Zurich]

Lake Zurich is the famous icy lake in Switzerland. The scenery of Lake Zurich is superb, with medieval pebble trails along the river for visitors to take a walk by the lake, swimming, picnicking, sunbathing and boat trips to the Lake District.

### [Bahnhofstrasse]

Bahnhofstrasse in Zurich, Switzerland is the richest street in the world. The main street was built during the Roman rule in 15 BC and became one of the most prosperous and "expensive" streets in the city.

**Tour Overview**

After breakfast, head to Bern. The Swiss capital is a total work of art. [The old town of Bern] has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1983. You can stroll through Bern's old town with its many arcades. Next, head to Lausanne to visit [the Old Town], which retains its medieval style. Then take a tour to "Pearl of Lake Geneva" — Montreux. Mystical, almost magical, [Chillon Castle] stands on a rocky island around three kilometers from Montreux, which is well worth a visit. Overnight in Fribourg or nearby.

### [Château de Chillon]

### [Bern Old Town]

Built in the 12th century on the hills surrounded by the Ahr River, it became the capital of Switzerland in 1848. The ancient city preserves the 16th century elegant arched promenade and fountain. In 1983, it was included in the World Heritage List by UNESCO.

### [Lausanne Old Town]

Lausanne is known as the "Olympic Capital" and the Olympic Museum and the Cathedral of the Madonna in the Old Town are all iconic sights.

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## **Day 3** Fribourg Interlaken Lucerne

 **Tour Overview**

Start your tour in Interlaken. The location between two of the most beautiful lakes Thun and Brienz in Switzerland is what makes Interlaken so special. A visit to Top of Europe—[Jungfrau] (optional) puts a jewel in the crown of any visit to Switzerland. For more than 100 years, the Jungfrau railway has been making its journey to Europe's highest-altitude railway station at 3454 metres. All through the year, the cog railway runs steeply up through a tunnel to the Jungfrau from Kleine Scheidegg. One stop within the tunnel offers spectacular views onto the glacier world outside through windows in the Eiger North Face. Interlaken is also a paradise for aviation enthusiasts. [Take a paragliding tandem flight (optional)] (only Apr-Oct) and get a bird's eye view of the fascinating winter landscape of the Swiss Alps. Here you can enjoy a unique view of the majestic Jungfrau and charming Interlaken. Overnight in Lucerne or nearby.

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## Paragliding Flight (Apr-Oct)

#### 1.insurance

The pilot has taken out accident insurance for the passenger with a scope limited to Switzerland and with maximum cover of CHF 100,000.

#### 2. Altitude sickness

The altitude of Beatenberg is 1,350 meters, and the altitude of Interlaken is 800 meters. The altitude is moderate and generally does not cause altitude sickness.

#### 3. Clothes

Dress according to the weather conditions. Wear sturdy shoes with sturdy soles (hiking shoes or sneakers). Even in summer a sweater or windbreaker can protect you from the wind. You may wear sunglasses during your flight.

#### 4. Accompanying Person

We recommend spectators wait at our landing field. Non-flying passengers are not allowed to go to take off.

#### 5. Bad weather

Should our experienced pilots rate the weather as unsafe to fly, we will contact you before your flight. Please be aware that this decision is made for safety reasons and can be made last minute. You have the possibility to rebook your flight or get a full refund.

## Day 4 Lucerne Schaffhausen Stuttgart Frankfurt



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Lucerne. In addition to the unmistakable cityscape with the lake and historic old town, Lucerne offers many sights. [The Chapel Bridge] with its cycle of paintings is the undisputed landmark of Lucerne. It runs from the New Town past the water tower to the Town Hall Quay. The path through the picturesque old town leads you to another popular sight, the [Lion of Lucerne]. Then we will go to Schaffhausen, the town is in the "knee" of the Rhine in Eastern Switzerland on the border with Germany, to visit [Rheinfall](optional). After the tour, return to Frankfurt via Stuttgart. Arrival at Stuttgart train station at 16:00 Arrive at Frankfurt train station at 19:00 (The above time is for reference only)

### [Chapel Bridge]

Chapel Bridge is a covered wooden footbridge spanning the river Reuss diagonally in Lucerne. Named after the nearby St. Peter's Chapel, the bridge is unique in containing a number of interior paintings dating back to the 17th century, although many of them were destroyed along with a larger part of the centuries-old bridge in a 1993 fire. Subsequently restored, the Kapellbrücke is the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe, as well as the world's oldest surviving truss bridge. It serves as the city's symbol and as one of Switzerland's main tourist attractions.

### [Rhine Falls]

The waterfall on the upper reaches of the Rhine, currently the largest waterfall in Europe. You will feel its majestic and majestic in Schaffhausen.

### [Lion monument]

The dying Lucerne lion is one of the most famous statues in the world, and the famous writer Mark Twain called it "the most tragic and touching statue in the world."
