### [Zurich Cathedral]

The Zurich Cathedral is one of the three main churches in Zurich, Switzerland (the other two are the Cathedral of Our Lady of Zurich and St. Peter's Church). The church is located near the banks of the Limmat River. Today's church was built around 1100 and was unveiled around 1220. According to legend, the earliest church was created for Charlemagne. The Zurich Cathedral is a monastery church that competes with the Cathedral of Our Lady of Zurich across the Limmat River in the Middle Ages. Charlemagne's mount stumbled in front of the tombs of the main saints Felix and Regula in Zurich. According to legend, it was earlier than the Cathedral of Our Lady, which was built by the grandson of Charlemagne. Recent archaeological evidence proves that this is the Roman cemetery.

### [Lake Zurich]

Lake Zurich is the famous icy lake in Switzerland. The scenery of Lake Zurich is superb, with medieval pebble trails along the river for visitors to take a walk by the lake, swimming, picnicking, sunbathing and boat trips to the Lake District.

### [Bahnhofstrasse]

Bahnhofstrasse in Zurich, Switzerland is the richest street in the world. The main street was built during the Roman rule in 15 BC and became one of the most prosperous and "expensive" streets in the city.


### [Chapel Bridge]

Chapel Bridge is a covered wooden footbridge spanning the river Reuss diagonally in Lucerne. Named after the nearby St. Peter's Chapel, the bridge is unique in containing a number of interior paintings dating back to the 17th century, although many of them were destroyed along with a larger part of the centuries-old bridge in a 1993 fire. Subsequently restored, the Kapellbrücke is the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe, as well as the world's oldest surviving truss bridge. It serves as the city's symbol and as one of Switzerland's main tourist attractions.

### [Lion monument]

The dying Lucerne lion is one of the most famous statues in the world, and the famous writer Mark Twain called it "the most tragic and touching statue in the world."

### [Annecy Town]

### [Pope palace]

Originally built in 1334, it covers an area of about 15,000 square meters and is the largest and most important medieval Gothic building in Europe. In 1906, the palace was transformed into a national museum. There are now more than 20 rooms to visit, including the Pope's room, and a review of historical events.

### [Rock park]

Behind the cathedral is the origin of the history of Avignon, now a public park, a popular outdoor place for people to go.

### [Broken bridge]

It was first completed in 1185 and appeared in French nursery rhymes. It is 900 meters long and spans the Rhone River, connecting the Old Town with the New Town. In the 17th century, a flood washed the bridge, and only a part of the broken bridge survived to this day.

### [Notre Dame Cathedral]

Rebuilt in the middle of the twelfth century, it is the oldest religious building in Avignon. The church has a bell tower with a total of 35 clocks. It is said that the sound of the French bell tower is the second loudest. Each bell has its own name. Because the size is different, the sound is different.

#### [Park Guell]

Park Guell is one of the most dazzling sights in Barcelona and a masterpiece of garden design in Gaudi's many works. The artificial landscape here looks more natural than the natural landscape. The use of color and lines has also reached its peak. The entire city will be seen through the heights of the park.

#### [Mira House]

The Villa Mila was built between 1906 and 1912 in the Eixample extension of the city of Barcelona, Spain, on the Passeig de Gracia. The vault of the La Pedrera, in the shape of a parabola or catenary.

The La Pedrera is the last private residence designed by Gaudí and is often referred to as La Pedrera (Catalan, meaning "quarry"). Three wavy walls, balcony railings made of twisted iron bars and iron plates, and large windows are very eye-catching. In 1986, the La Pedrera was bought by Caixa de Catalunya Bank and costly to renovate. The first floor is now the venue for the exhibition of the bank's foundation. The six-storey, top-floor and roof terraces of the Mira House are open to the public, and the chimneys on the roof are very special. On the balcony, you can also overlook some of the downtown streets and look at the Sagrada Familia.

#### [Barcelona Olympic Stadium]

**The Barcelona Olympic Stadium** is the venue for the 1992 Olympic Games, the most famous of which is the Olympic Ring.

**[Plaza Catalunya]**

Located in the heart of Barcelona, the Plaza Catalunya is connected to the old town and the extension. It is also the starting point for the city's main streets, Rambla and Gracia. The beautiful wide square is covered with green lawns, and there are beautiful stone statues of the goddess of peace, and the posture is peaceful and dignified: the fountain of flying beads jumping jade is diverse, just like the Crystal Palace.

**[Sagrada Familia]**

Sacred House - Sagrada Familia, a church group consisting of many spires and towers, a masterpiece by Gaudi, a famous Catalan architect. Originally built in 1884, the slender lines are the main feature, and the dome and interior structure show neo-gothic style.

**[Rambla]**

Rambla Street is located in Barcelona and is the first spacious street there. Because the various wandering artists perform various kinds of entertainment performances here, there are many vivid sculptures along the street, so there is a more familiar name, which is the Street of the Wanderers. The long "satin ribbon" that extends from Plaza Catalunya to the port area is more than 1,800 meters long and is divided into five sections, especially the street where the Flower Street and Urumqi are located.

### [Lyon Old Town]

The Fertile Square is the heart of Lyon. Continued to the north is the red cross block in the silk-weaving center mentioned above. This old block preserves many pale old houses from the 15th to the 17th century. The orange-red color is bright and eye-catching. Many Gothic, Renaissance and classical houses are connected to each other, making people feel that the times have changed and Lyon has a long history.

### [St. Jean's Chief Cathedral]

Construction began in 1180 and lasted for three centuries. This church is not particularly grand, but its qualifications are very old and its status is high. It has a history of nearly a thousand years and is both Romance and Gothic.

### [Palace of the Dukes of Burgundy]

The Palace of the Dukes and Estates of Burgundy, located in Dijon, is a remarkable example of preserved architecture. The oldest parts of the palace date back to the 14th and 15th centuries, showcasing the Gothic style of the period. These include the ducal palace, the seat of the Dukes of Burgundy, and various other structures such as the ducal kitchens and the tour de Philippe le Bon.

### [Place de la Libération]

The Place de la Libération, in the heart of Dijon's historic centre, is a royal square dating from the late 17th century. It took its current name in 1948. Located in front of the Palace of the Dukes of Burgundy, it was designed as a setting for a bronze equestrian statue of Louis XIV, which was destroyed during the French Revolution.

### [Church of Notre-Dame of Dijon]

The Church of Notre-Dame of Dijon is a Roman Catholic church in Dijon. Considered a masterpiece of 13th-century Gothic architecture, it is situated at the heart of the preserved old centre of the city. Work on the church began around 1230. The church contains the statue of Notre-Dame de Bon-Espoir, formerly called the Black Madonna. The church's decorations also include two symbols of Dijon: the jacquemart (bell-striking automaton) and the owl. The church was classified as a Monument Historique in the List of historic monuments of 1840.
