[Karl Marx's house]

Introduction: The house where Karl Marx was born is located at brückenstraße 10, the edge of today's pedestrian street. The founder of modern socialism was born here on May 5, 1818. His socioeconomic ideology was probably based on Trier's critical economic situation in his time.

[Porta Nigra]

The best-preserved classical period gate has now become a symbol of Trier, the cosmopolitan city of Moselle.

[Alte Brücke]

The ancient bridge of Heidelberg, also known as Karl-Theodor-Brücke, is located in Heidelberg, Germany. It was built in 1896 and has a history of more than 200 years.

[Heidelberg Castle]

Heidelberg Castle is situated on the top of the King's throne, with many historical sites and historically expanded several times to form a mixture of Gothic, Baroque and Renaissance styles, a masterpiece of the German Renaissance. The main entrance of the castle is carved with armored warriors, the central garden has a fountain and four granite columns, surrounded by concert halls, glass halls and other buildings. Most of the rooms in the ancient city are open to visitors, and some well-preserved halls are still available for banquets and art performances. The "big barrel" and the large wine cellar that can store 220,000 liters of wine in the fort are the most attractive attractions in Heidelberg.

[Place de la Constitution]

Located in the old city of Luxembourg, the most visible landmark is the Memorial Monument to the fallen soldiers who commemorated the death of the First World War in Luxembourg, separated from the corners of the square, opposite the famous Church of Our Lady. The Constitution Square is also the best place to see the Grand Canyon and its scenery on both sides.

[Grand Canyon of Luxembourg]

The gorge is long and deep, full of green, and the stream flows quietly in the green grass. The ancient trees on both sides of the strait are towering, lush and layered, beautiful. In the shadow of the trees, a palace-like building is located in the greenery, which is particularly spectacular.

[Seine]

The Seine is a 777-kilometre-long (483 mi) river in northern France. Nearly its whole length is available for recreational boating; excursion boats offer sightseeing tours of the river banks in the capital city, Paris.

[Montparnasse Tower]

The Montparnasse Tower is 210 meters high and is the tallest building in Paris. When the weather is fine, the observation deck from the top floor can be seen as far as 40 kilometers away. It is the best way to see the metropolis of Paris. Away from the hustle and bustle of Montparnasse Square, standing at the highest point of Huadu, the bustling city has a panoramic view. See the maps prepared for you in advance to identify the location of each district and the various architectural attractions.

In the afternoon, head to Brussels, the vibrant capital of Belgium, known for its diverse character and charm. Explore the [Grand Place], a UNESCO World Heritage site, admire the [Atomium], a striking structure from the 1958 World Expo, and see the famous [Manneken Pis], a small statue of a boy that has become a symbol of the city's quirky spirit. Overnight in Brussels or nearby.

[Grand Place, Brussels]

On the square stands the majestic Brussels City Hall, the famous peeing child in the city, strolling through the streets of Brussels city centre, delicious waffles, you will be able to appreciate this "the most beautiful square in Europe" The mellow taste you bring.

[Atomic tower]

Located on the northwestern outskirts of Brussels, the capital of Belgium, the Hessel Heights is one of the top ten attractions in Brussels and is known as the Belgian Eiffel Tower. Visitors can enjoy the fascinating scenery of the surrounding area through the surrounding organic clear glass overlooking the cityscape of Brussels.

[Manneken Pis]

Introduction: The bronze statue of a peeing child is a landmark in Brussels and is known as the "first citizen of Brussels" . The bronze statue is located at the corner of the downtown square, about half a meter high. It is a little boy with a light chest and peeing, and the image is realistic. Legend has it that the Spanish occupiers planned to use explosives to blow up the city when they left Brussels. Fortunately, the boy urinated at night and poured out the fuse to save the city. In order to commemorate the little hero, this image was carved. The statue was built in 1619. In 1747, Louis XV of France had clothed him for the sake of "excellent view" . The King' s House next to the square houses hundreds of costumes for peeing children from all over the country. It is worth seeing.

[Bruges City Hall]


Bruges City Hall is the town hall of West Flanders Bruges, Belgium. This is one of the oldest town halls in the lowland countries. The Bruges City Hall is located in the Castle Square and was built in 1376 and completed in 1421. Late Gothic style, rectangular plane with turret. The impressively rich design reflects the economic prosperity of Bruges in the 14th century. On the walls and on the tomb of Count Flanders are pictures of the Bible and historical figures.

[Bruges Clock Tower]

The clock tower is located next to the main church. This clock tower can be said to be a symbol of Bruges, representing power and freedom. The clock tower is 83 meters high, and it takes 366 steps to reach the top of the building. Standing on the top of the building, you can overlook the entire city of Bruges. Daily timekeeping is the most important job at the moment, and it will also ring during major events or gatherings. Every day, there are a variety of musicians playing beautiful music in the bell tower, which is completed by 47 ancient clocks in the clock tower. Now the square where the clock tower is located is the most concentrated place for tourists and locals. You will also see the scene here in the movie "The Killer Without Holidays".

[Basilica of the Holy Blood]

The Holy Blood brought back by the Crusades of the 12th century was placed on the altar of the church. The church is a Roman-style double structure. The church above is a Gothic building from the 15th to the 16th century. The following is dedicated to St. Basili Ers's ashes hall.

[Champs Elysees]

The most romantic street in Paris is also home to a variety of fashion big names.

[Arc de Triomphe]

The Arc de Triomphe honours those who fought and died for France in the French Revolutionary and Napoleonic Wars, with the names of all French victories and generals inscribed on its inner and outer surfaces. Beneath its vault lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier from World War I. The four sculptural groups at the base of the Arces represent "Departure", "Victory", "Resistance" and "Peace" respectively.

[Musée du Louvre]

One of the world's three major museums, with more than 400,000 art collections, sculptures from the Middle Ages to modern times, an amazing number of royal treasures and fine paintings.

[Place de la Concorde]

Louis XVI and Queen Mary were executed here, where you can admire the magnificent Egyptian obelisk and the magnificent Poseidon and the River God Fountain.

[Eiffel Tower]

The Eiffel Tower is a wrought-iron lattice tower on the Champ de Mars in Paris, France. It is named after the engineer Gustave Eiffel, whose company designed and built the tower from 1887 to 1889. Locally nicknamed "La dame de fer" (French for "Iron Lady"), it was constructed as the centerpiece of the 1889 World's Fair, and to crown the centennial anniversary of the French Revolution. Although initially criticised by some of France's leading artists and intellectuals for its design, it has since become a global cultural icon of France and one of the most recognisable structures in the world.

[Galeries Lafayette]

As one of the top department stores, Galeries Lafayette has been established since the end of the 19th century. In the eyes of the French, it is not only the perfect place to buy top fashion items, but also the epitome and birthplace of French fashion culture.

Dam Square is arguably the most vibrant part of the city, filled with coffee scent, funny street performers and tourists from all over the world. Dam Square is also the birthplace of the city of Amsterdam.

[Amsterdam cruise]

Amsterdam's unique canal always gives visitors a lot of charm. Day and night, summer and winter, Amsterdam's canal is always ready to enjoy her style throughout the year.

[The Hague Peace Palace]

The Peace Palace was built in 1907 and lasted for six years. During the construction of the Peace Palace, it was also received by many countries, most of which were used in the construction and decoration of the Peace Palace. The palace was named Peace Palace to express its importance to resolving disputes and maintaining world peace. It is an important building symbolizing the pursuit of world peace and justice and a venue for resolving disputes between UN member states.

[Scheveningen]





Scheveningen is the most famous seaside resort in the Netherlands. At the end of the 19th century, people came here to enjoy a healthy spa, like the popular SPA today. At that time, the health center - Kurhaus has now been transformed into a luxurious hotel, and the palace-style architectural appearance has become one of the local sightseeing spots. Close to The Hague, from the centre of The Hague to the coast of Scheveningen, a 10-minute tram ride will take you to the leisure area on the coast of Scheveningen, where you can enjoy the sun, the sea and the beach. In addition to a variety of beach activities, you can also go to casinos, shopping malls, digital cinemas, etc., or find a delicious seafood restaurant.

[Cube House Rotterdam]

Designed by renowned Dutch architect Piet Blom, the three-dimensional box house consists of 38 bright yellow square houses that shine under the blue sky. The three-dimensional box house was built in 1982 and was completed in 1984. The designed cube house is like an abstract tree, and the whole community is like a forest, hence the name "tree house". The three-dimensional box house shows the form, aesthetics and space effect. It looks inclined and only one point is placed on the pillar, so the three faces the ground and the other three faces the sky. The three-dimensional block building complex has always attracted visitors from the Netherlands and around the world with its unique shape.

The 19 nostalgic windmills built around 1740 have been preserved to this day and have been listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site and the largest existing windmill in the Netherlands.
