[Gothenburg Cathedral]

Gothenburg Cathedral stands on a hill called mastugget, and its distinctive symbol is the church tower that is more than 60 meters high. Above the hills, you can get a bird's eye view of the entire Gothenburg city, especially the port terminal. The church is a Nordic building that represents the national romantic style and has become a symbol of Gothenburg.

[Poseidon statue of Poseidon]

The statue was completed in 1931 and is a symbol of Swedish maritime hegemony and the maritime era. The statue of Poseidon is a heroic figure, showing a beautiful male curve and is one of the most famous statues in Gothenburg.

After breakfast, we will head to Oslo, the capital of Norway, to visit one of Oslo's landmarks [Vigelandsparken]. With over six hundred human sculptures, the park showcases the creative work of sculptor Gustav Vigeland, spanning more than 20 years. Life is the theme of Vigelandsparken, where you can stroll through the art garden and experience representations of all stages of life. Next, we will visit the [Oslo Opera House]. The appearance of the lines is simple but full of design. The roof made up of marble and glass makes her look like a glacier floating on the sea. Tourists are welcomed to walk on the roof to see the beauty of Oslo. Overnight stay in Hemsedal or nearby.

[Vigeland Sculpture Park]

The Vigeland Sculpture Park is named after the famous sculptor Gustav Vigeland, which has 192 sculptures and a total of 650 statues. The central idea of all the statues in the Welland Sculpture Park focuses on a theme - "life", which shows people from birth to death, giving visitors a lot of life enlightenment, so it is also called "life journey park".

[Oslo Opera House]

Oslo Opera House opposite the small Oslo Fjord, the architectural style like a ship, it is the second built in the early 14th century Trondheim (Trondheim) of Nideluosi cathedral after (Nidarosdomen Cathedral), Norway's largest cultural building. From the outside of the theatre, the most striking feature is the white sloping stone roof that rises from the Oslofjord, where visitors can stroll through the rooftops and enjoy the cityscape of Oslo. Sometimes there is a free open-air concert outside the opera house where visitors can sit on the deck and enjoy the sea while enjoying the music.

Take the [Flåm Train] (optional) to experience one of the world's most scenic train journeys. The trip from Flåm to Myrdal and back takes approximately 2 hours, offering breathtaking views of the Norwegian countryside, steep mountains, cascading waterfalls, and lush valleys along the way. After returning to Flåm, we will head to Gudvangen, where you can take a cruise (optional) for about 1.5h to enjoy the world's deepest and longest fjord [Sognefjorden], which is ranked as one of the best-preserved fjords in the world. Overnight stay in Voss or nearby. *Please book the tickets for the Flåm Train in advance during summer season.

[Sognefjord]

The Sognefjord is Norway's largest fjord and the longest and deepest fjord in the world, with a total length of 204 kilometers and a depth of 1,308 meters. The Sognefjord is one of the most convenient transportations among the four major fjords. It is ranked first in the world's best-preserved and most worthwhile destination by the National Geographic and Travel Magazine. There are no glaciers in the summer, but there are still waterfalls, flat lakes, and cliffs.

[Flåm Alpine Railway]

Connected to the starting point of the Sognefjord – the small town of Flåm and the Midar Mountains, which took 22 years to complete, is hailed as a great engineering miracle in Norwegian history and the most magnificent, steepest and most famous mountain in the world. One of the railways. Visitors can enjoy beautiful scenery such as waterfalls, snow mountains, cliffs and canyons along the way.

[Hardangerfjord]

The Hardangerfjord is the gentlest of the four major fjords and has an idyllic landscape of the fjord. About 800 years ago, the monks planted apple trees and almond trees here, and they bloomed every May, and the summer results. It is worth seeing that there are waterfalls, nature parks, glaciers, etc.

[Nur Hemsson Town]

The town of Norheimsund is located at the end of a corner bay of the Hardangerfjord, in a valley surrounded by mountains. Colorful wooden houses are dotted on the hillside, shaded by the rich and beautiful nature. A beautiful Norwegian fjord town is presented before your eyes.

[Edfjord]

Eidfjord is located at the eastern end of the Hardangerfjord. This area has steep mountains, huge waterfalls, deserted farms and winding roads. The scenery is very beautiful.

[Old city of Bryggen]

When I arrived in Bergen, I had to go to Bryggen, literally translated as the pier. As one of the world's cultural heritage, it has become a business card for travel in Bergen and even Norway. It can be seen in the large and small tourist albums in Norway. A row of colored wooden houses in the Hanseatic League is the landmark of the pier. These houses, which were rebuilt after a fire in 1702, have been in existence for more than 300 years. These huts are still commercialized today and are rented to many shops, restaurants, cafes, etc., where you can buy souvenirs.

[Oslo City Hall]

The Oslo City Hall is the awarding place for the annual Nobel Peace Prize. From the outside, it looks like a slightly serious government office building, but after entering, the walls of the memorial hall are full of beautiful murals depicting Norwegian history and mythology.

[Akershus Castle]

Akershus Castle is a majestic castle standing on the edge of the Cape Aker. It was designed and built by King Novo V of Norway in 1300 to resist foreign aggression. It is one of the most representative buildings in the Middle Ages. Today, castles are often used to entertain foreign guests. Visitors can experience the history of Oslo here, as well as overlooking the whole of Oslo.

[Oslo Palace]

The Oslo Palace (1825 - 1848) was built in the 19th century and is the office of King Harald. The palace is built on a highland, directly opposite the main street of the city - Karl Johann Street, surrounded by the Royal Palace is 330 acres of woodland and parks, passing through the public avenue directly to the downtown business district.

[Amalienborg Palace]

The Royal Palace of Denmark, the Amalienborg Palace, is located on the shore of the Orson Strait in the eastern part of Copenhagen. The Amerinburg Palace is the main palace of the Danish royal family. It consists of four palaces and was built between 1754 and 1760.

[Pier park]

Denmark is known as the fairy tale kingdom. The mermaid statue in the pier park is the daughter of Andersen' s fairy tale sea.

[Mermaid bronze statue]

The Long Beach Park in the northeast of Copenhagen, Denmark, was cast by Danish sculptor Edvard Eriksen according to Andersen's fairy tale "The Daughter of the Sea" and is already a symbol of Denmark.

[Newport]

Built in an artificial canal between 1669 and 1673, she introduced the sea water directly to the King's New Square, thus promoting economic development. It is made up of many brightly coloured homes (built in the 17th and early 18th centuries), bars, cafes and restaurants, and is therefore a landmark tourist destination in Copenhagen. The place is not big, but the summer of Newport is beautiful – sparkling The meandering river, the various boats on both sides and the colored houses complement each other.
