#### Tour Overview

☆ 09:00 Depart from our meeting point in the center of Paris for the first stop of the day: Palace of Versailles. ☆ 09:45 A UNESCO World Heritage site, the [Palace of Versailles] was the residence of the Kings of France Louis XIV, Louis XV and Louis XVI from 1682 until the French Revolution in 1789. It will take you back into the history of the Kings of France. ☆ 12:00 Lunch time. ☆ 12:30 Head to [Claude Monet's house and gardens- Giverny]. ☆ 14:00 Soak up the world of the painter, Claude Monet, famous for painting different corners of his garden, such as the "Water Lilies" or the "Japanese Bridge." ☆ 16:00 Head to Oville. ☆ 17:00 Arrive in [Oville], which is a typical French traditional village where Van Gogh spent the last 70 days of his life. It is known as the Van Gogh Town. Visit Orville Castle and Van Gogh's Former Residence. ☆ 18:00 Depart from Oville. ☆ 19:00 Arrive in Paris.

Monet Garden - Half of Monet's life has been spent here, creating countless books. Monet claimed that "the garden is my most beautiful work." Fully show the post-impressionism here. Since Monet's death, it has been maintained in the same way as Monet's life. In the former residence, the remains of Monet's life have been preserved as well. At the same time, you will find that Monet was obsessed with the art of Japanese ukiyo-e, and the underground passages of the colorful gardens and bamboo groves were excavated by the owner. Together, in the Gion, you can find that the Japanese Bridge echoes in the Lily Pond! Beautiful ~ colorful ~, Monet Garden will let you call the master of photography - every photo in your hand is a colorful and beautiful painting!

#### **[Former residence of Van Gogh]**

The former residence of Van Gogh was the place where Van Gogh lived and died. The former residence of Van Gogh is located in the small town of Auvers-SUR-OISE in France. On the right bank of the Oise River, 30 km from the outskirts of Paris, the last 70 days of Van Gogh's life was spent here.
