#### Tour Overview

☆08:30 Depart from Frankfurt and head to Würzburg. Würzburg is a pleasant harmony of history, culture and wine. This university city and former royal seat is idyllically situated on either side of the Main River and offers a vibrant atmosphere and an endearing charm. ☆10:00 Visit Würzburg, the "City of Churches". Würzburg's famous landmarks are the [Würzburg Residence] with its Court Gardens and Residence Square (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), the [Marienberg Fortress] and the 180-metre-long [Old Main Bridge], which is lined with impressive statues of saints. [Würzburger Dom] and [Marienkapelle] are also not to be missed. Gracefully straddling the banks of the Main River amid idyllic vineyards, the location alone is reason enough to visit Würzburg. ☆12:00 Lunch time. ☆13:00 Head to Rothenburg. ☆14:00 Visit Rothenburg. Discover the [Rothenburg Town Hall], an example of medieval architecture with its impressive façade. Explore the [St.Jakob's Church], known for its beautiful Gothic design and the famous altar. Continue to the [Rothenburg City Walls], which offer a glimpse into the city's historical defense structures. ☆16:00 Return to Frankfurt. ☆18:00 Arrival in Frankfurt, the trip ends.

### **[Würzburg official residence]**

Listed on the World Heritage List by UNESCO, it is one of the most famous palaces in southern Germany. It is a representative building of the late Baroque in Europe. It is in the Baroque style and is often compared with the Schönbrunn Palace and the Palace of Versailles in Vienna.

### **[Main River Old Bridge]**

It is the most beautiful bridge on the Main River in the town of Würzburg. It is at the foot of the Marion Mountain and overlooked by the Marion Castle. It is the only way from the castle to the old town.

### **[Rothenburg City Hall]**

Dating back to the 14th century, the Gothic and Renaissance mixed-style towers offer sweeping views of the city and the Tauber Valley.

### **[St. Jacob's Cathedral]**

It is the most important church in the city of Rothenburg, and the Gothic building was built in the 14th century. The church houses the Heilig Blut Altar, which depicts the last supper and is said to be dedicated to the Holy Blood of Christ.

### **[Rothenburg Wall]**

It has a total length of 2.5 kilometers and is completely surrounded by Rothenburg. There are passages on the wall to walk, roofs to shelter from wind and rain, and more than 30 towers dotted with large and small.

### **[Church of the Virgin]**

The Church of the Virgin, located next to the Falcon House, was formerly a smashed synagogue. During World War II, the church was burnt down and reconstruction was completed in 1948-1961. The building has a distinctive Gothic style, red and white walls, and the towering spires, which are particularly striking in contrast to the colors of the sky.
