#### **Tour Overview**

In the morning, gather in Athens and depart for the Peloponnese, where myt h meets history. Visit [Corinth Canal], [Palamidi] and [Nafplio]. In the evening, we head to Kyllini port to take a ferry to Zakynthos Island. The reference ferry schedule is: 17:00-18:15 or 17:15-18:30, which takes about 75 minutes. Overnight in Zakynthos.

## [Acropolis open-air ancient theater]

The magical effect of the Dionysius Theatre in the Acropolis complex is its acoustics. At the edge of the huge semi-circular theater, the audience can still hear the sighs of the actors as clearly as the audience in the front row. The theater has been in use for 2000 years and is still in use today.

## [Mountain gate]

Translated into Propilai, built between 437 and 432 BC, the architect Mnesicles, located on the steep slope of the west end of the Acropolis, is the entrance to the Acropolis, in order to adapt to local conditions, to create an asymmetrical form.

## [Goddess of Victory, Athena Niki]

The Temple of Athena Nike was built between 449 and 421 BC. It is also known as the Temple of Athena Victory, the Temple of Niki, the Temple of Wingless Victory, located on the Acropolis Hill. It adopts the Ionian column type. The base is 8.15 meters long and 5.38 meters wide. The front and rear colonnades are exquisitely carved. It is the architectural art of the Dorians and Ionians who lived in Athens. In the eyes of the Greeks, Athena is the goddess who represents wisdom, skill and victory.

## [Dionysus Amphitheatre]

The Dionysos Theater in Athens is located on the south side of the Acropolis. It has two semi-circular theaters connected by a porch, which fully reflects the ancient Greeks' love of art. The Odium of Herodes Attius Theatre on the west side is still used as a venue for summer open-air concerts and theatre performances, and the Bacchus Theatre on the east side is open to visitors as an attraction. The theater was built in the 5th century BC and was the first place to pray to Dionysus.

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# Day 2 Zakynthos



#### **Tour Overview**

After breakfast, we head to explore the [Navagio Shipwreck]. Between steep cliffs, crystal-clear blue waters, and pristine white sands lies an old, rusted ship. In 1983, the Panagiotis, a ship smuggling cigarettes to and from Sicily, Italy, was wrecked and stranded there. In addition, also take a boat to [Blue Cave], where nature's artistry has carved out caverns in the cliffs through the ero sive power of the sea. Due to light refraction, the water in the caves presents an incredible blue, as clear as sapphire. The water is so transparent that the marine life, including seaweed and moss on the cave walls and sponges on the seabed, can be clearly seen. In the afternoon, you' Il have free time to stroll through Solomos Square in [Zakynthos Town].

#### Note:

After assessing the risk of landslides and seismic activity, the Greek government has decided to close Navagio Bay for safety reasons, meaning it will not be open to tourists this summer. As a result, landing on the beach will not be possible. However, we can still take a cruise into the bay and take photos from a safe distance offshore.

If the weather is good, we will enter the Blue Cave and Navagio Shipwreck Bay by boat. If the weather is bad and sailing is not permitted, we will instead visit scenic spots in Zakynthos town or participate in other tour activities arranged by the guide according to the actual situation. ## [Nafplio]

One of the most beautiful towns in the area of Argolis (in eastern Peloponnese) as well as one of the most romantic cities all over Greece, Nafplio was the first capital of the newly born Greek state between 1823 and 1834. According to mythology, the town was founded by Nafplios, the son of god Poseidon and the daughter of Danaus (Danaida) Anymone.

## [Corinth Canal]

The Corinth Canal is an artificial canal in Greece that connects the Gulf of Corinth in the Ionian Sea with the Saronic Gulf in the Aegean Sea. It cuts through the narrow Isthmus of Corinth and separates the Peloponnese from the Greek mainland, making the peninsula an island. The canal was dug through the Isthmus at sea level and has no locks. It is 6.4 kilometres (4 miles) in length and only 24.6 metres (80.7 feet) wide at sea level.

## [Palamidi Fortress]

Palamidi is a fortress to the east of the Acronauplia in the town of Nafplio in the Peloponnese region of southern Greece. It is a typical baroque fortress based on the plans of Venetian engineer Antonio Giancix and built by French military engineer Pierre de la Salle. When the Greeks overthrew the Turks the bastions were renamed after ancient Greek leaders and heroes.

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#### Tour Overview

After breakfast, take a boat back to Kyllini port, where you will then head to Mycenae, named after one of the greatest prehistoric civilizations in Greek - t he Mycenaean civilization. The archeological site of Mycenae was added to t he UNESCO World Heritage List in 1999 and preserves the magnificent remains of the city that ruled the eastern Mediterranean from the 15th century BC E to the 12th century BCE, playing a crucial role in the development of classic al Greek culture. Explore the [Ancient Mycenae], known for the city of Agame mnon in mythology of the Trojan War. Overnight in or near Athens.

Shipwreck Bay [Shipwreck Bay]

Zakynthos Island is a shipwreck bay on the Mediterranean coast of Greece, known as the world's most beautiful coast. The filming of "The Descendants of the Sun" was smashed by the smuggling ship Panagiotis in 1983 when it was transporting cigarettes. Shipwreck Bay". Steep cliffs and clear blue waters, the vast white sand, the white sand reflects the sun's rays, and the crystal clear water is intoxicating. There is a "blue hole" nearby that is very famous for its perfect combination of rocky seaweed and sunlight.

# Day 4 Athens ■ Santorini

After breakfast, take a ferry from Piraeus Port in Athens to Santorini Island (the sailing time usually ranges from 07:25 to 14:50, depending on the specific schedule of the ferry company). Upon arrival at [Santorini Island] in the after noon, head to [Oia] to enjoy the sunset. The blue sky and ocean create a vast backdrop, while white houses perched on towering cliffs stand silently, waiting for every sunrise and sunset over the Aegean Sea.

## [Mycenae]

The Archaeological Sites of Mycenae and Tiryns, located in the Regional unit of Argolis in the North-East Peloponnese, are the imposing ruins of the two greatest cities of the Mycenaean civilization, renowned for its technical and artistic achievements but also its spiritual wealth, which spread around the Mediterranean world between 1600 and 1100 BC and played a vital role in the development of classical Greek culture. The palatial administrative system, the monumental architecture, the impressive artefacts and the first testimonies of Greek language, preserved on Linear B tablets, are unique elements of the Mycenaean culture; a culture that inspired the great poet Homer to compose his famous epic poems.

# Day 5 Santorini

## **Tour Overview**

Enjoy the stunning scenery of Santorini all day. [5-Hour Sailing Cruise with M eals Included](Optional) Sail across the crystal-clear waters of Santorini to reach the famous Red Beach, known for its breathtaking and dramatic scener y, and then head to the beautiful White Beach. Visit the unique Black Mounta in, formed naturally after a volcanic eruption. After sailing close to the Veneti an Lighthouse, the next stop will be the Volcano of Nea Kameni and the hot springs, where you can enjoy swimming, fishing, and dining while taking in t he wild scenery and the volcanic atmosphere. You can also try diving or snor keling in the clear blue waters. Snorkeling equipment is available on board. A fterwards, a fresh meal will be served, featuring local seafood and barbecue. An open bar will also be available, offering beverages. Before heading back t o port and ending the tour, enjoy the mesmerizing views of Santorini and the clear waters of the Aegean Sea. (In winter, if swimming is not possible, the to ur will typically arrange a visit to the volcanic island.) [Black Beach] Santorini 's unique volcanic geology has created the distinctive black sand beach at Kamari. The long black sand beach was formed from volcanic ash deposited after eruptions and is a popular vacation spot on the eastern side of Santorin i. [Active Volcano] (Optional) Take a boat tour to the active volcano, where yo u can hike up to see the smoking crater and enjoy the natural hot springs in t he volcanic sea before returning. Those who choose not to participate can e njoy free time in Fira. [Fira] Enjoy your free time wandering around Fira, a to wn full of restaurants, bars, and various shops. You can visit the blue-domed churches or relax in a café while enjoying the sea breeze and the fairy-tale sc enery. Overnight in Santorini.

The order of the tours will be arranged according to the situation.

**Note: When participating in the volcano tour:** It is recommended to bring a bath towel and wear swimwear in advance, as there are no changing rooms on board. Guests who cannot swim should stay on the boat to enjoy the scenery and avoid jumping into the hot springs. Do not wear slippers, as the volcanic rocks on the island are hot and rough. The temperature on the island is high and there are no shops, so please bring bottled water.

And finally you can enjoy some free time in the old town [P LAKA], incorporating labyrinthine streets and neoclassical architecture. It is k nown as the "Neighborhood of the Gods" due to its proximity to the Acropol is and its many archaeological sites.

## [Santorini volcanic island]

**The crater of Santorini** is a large, largely flooded <u>crater</u> located in <u>the</u> southern <u>Aegean Sea</u>, 120 km north of <u>Crete</u>, Greece. It is visible above the water ring of <u>Santorini</u> archipelago, including the largest island of <u>Santorini</u> (Thera), surrounded by <u>therasia</u>, Asp Ronnie West Island, is the center of Nea Kameni.

## [Fira (FIRA) town]

Fira (also known as Thira) is the capital of the Greek island of Aegean, Santorini, a traditional residential settlement. The town has convenient transportation and many hotels. From here, there are direct buses to the towns of Oia, Black Beach and Red Beach. It can be said that it is the transit bus stop of Holy Island. Every season in July, August and September is basically crowded with tourists, many of whom are just married newcomers, come here for honeymoon, super romantic. The town is not big, it is very suitable for walking slowly. The layout of the town's alleys is exquisite, criss-crossing, up and down. The alleys are full of small shops selling traditional costumes, handicrafts, gold and silver jewellery, as well as many family-run small restaurants and cafes.
