Tour Overview

Early in the morning, we depart for [České Budějovice], a city with over 750 years of tradition, numerous impressive heritage sites and breathtaking countryside all around. It's famous for the Budweiser Budvar Brewery. In the afternoon, we will drive to visit[Cesky Krumlov]. Český Krumlov does not boast of its inscription on the UNESCO World Heritage List for nothing. Spectacular collection of buildings, mainly from the 16th century, winds around the meanders of the Vltava River. Overnight stay in Cesky Krumlov or nearby.

Budweiser Town

[Cesky Krumlov]

Krumlov (also known as CK Town) is a peach blossom source in Europe, a small red town left by the Bohemian kingdom. Surrounded by the vast Vltava River, the castle-centered medieval city on the other side of the river valley is boundless, and the red tile houses are full of ups and downs. On the outskirts of the town, you can see the most obvious landmark of Krumlov, the castle tower.

[Budweiser Town]

Bujejovice is the capital of the Czech Republic of South Bohemia, the home of Budweiser, and the old town is full of wonderful Baroque architecture. Since the 13th century, the area has been known for brewing beer. Budweiser beer originated from it, so it is also known as Budweiser town. There is a charming medieval old town with a central square in the old town, surrounded by beautiful buildings of Baroque and Renaissance style. On both sides of the street are well-preserved medieval-style buildings that vary in shape and color but are coordinated.

Tour Overview

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to the renowned [St. Wolfgang] region and explore the picturesque town of [Hallstatt], immersing yourself in the majestic mountains and serene natural landscapes. Later, journey to [Salzburg], the millennia-old city nestled at the northern foothills of the Alps. Stroll through the [Mirabell Gardens], a filming location for The Sound of Music, and visit the [Mozart Residence], home of the musical prodigy. Overnight stay in Salzburg or a nearby hotel.

[Mirabell Garden]

This baroque garden with Roman sculptures, fountains, gardens and labyrinths was once the place where the heroine Maria took the children to sing "Do-Re-Mi" in the famous film "The Voice of Music".

[Mozart House]

The place where the famous 18th century Austrian music master Mozart was born. The museum displays the violins, xylophones and pianos used by Mozart during his lifetime, music scores, letters, and blueprints for stage plays designed by himself.

[St. Wolfgang]

The town is located in central Austria. It is on the northern shore of the Wolfgangsee lake (close to the towns of Strobl and St. Gilgen, both in the State of Salzburg) at the foot of the Schafberg mountain.

Tour Overview

After breakfast at the hotel, visit the beautiful [Moon Lake] to enjoy the delightful and romantic lakeside scenery. Then proceed to the town of Melk to tour [Melk Abbey] (optional). This Baroque-style abbey boasts a grand exterior and an interior resplendent with gold and magnificent beauty. It houses numerous frescoes and a library collection, holding significant prestige and academic value. Return to Vienna to conclude the journey.
