#### Tour Overview

In the morning, proceed to Zaragoza. With more than 2,000 years of history, Zaragoza is known for its magnificent Basilica del Pilar, its Roman foundations, its cultural diversity, and the warmth of its people. [The Basilica of Nuestra Señora del Pilar] is the symbol of the city. Another must-see is the stunning [Aljafería Palace], originally built as a pleasure palace for the kings of the Taifa of Saraqusta. Overnight in Madrid or nearby.

## Day 2 Madrid 🚗 Segovia 🚗 Toledo



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will have sightseeing in Madrid, Madrid, cheerful and vibrant at all hours, is famous for being an open city. In addition to its famous museums, busy streets dotted with all kinds of shops, restaurants with world cuisine and unbeatable nightlife, Madrid will surprise you with its tranquil historic spots. Visit [Madrid Royal Palace] (optional), [Plaza Mayor], [Puerta del Sol], [Plaza de España] and [Gran Vía]. In the afternoon, travel to Segovia and visit the spectacular [Roman Aqueduct], a stunning double-arched structure set in the middle of the magnificent old city, and a Gothic church [Segovia Main Church]. Visit the [Segovia Castle], which is the prototype of the castle in the Disney animated films "Snow White" and "Sleeping Beauty". Overnight in Toledo or nearby.

## Day 3 Toledo 🚗 Cordoba 🚗 Sevilla



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will head to one of the oldest cities in Europe: Toledo. The city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and has, throughout history, been an outstanding example of the peaceful coexistence of three cultures: Jewish, Christian, and Muslim. We will visit the [Toledo Old Town] and the [Toledo Cathedral]. Next, head to Córdoba where you will visit several key landmarks: the [Roman Bridge], you will also explore [Alley of Flowers], a narrow street adorned with colorful flowerpots and typical Andalusian architecture. Finally, visit the [Córdoba Cathedral], a magnificent blend of Islamic and Christian architectural styles. Overnight in Sevilla or nearby.

### Tour Overview

In the morning, drive to the jewel of southern Spain - Seville, a historic city whose rise and fall encapsulate the story of the Spanish Empire. Upon arrival, we will visit [Plaza de España], [Catedral de Sevilla], [Real Alcázar de Sevilla]. Then head to [Ronda], where you will stroll through the Old Town and visit the famous [Puente Nuevo (New Bridge)], an iconic structure that spans the El Tajo Gorge. You will also have the chance to see the [Bullring], a site that marks Ronda's deep connection to bullfighting tradition. Afterwards, spend the afternoon at leisure in the "white town" of Mijas.

## Day 5 Malaga 🚗 Granada 🚗 The Pink Lake Of Torrevieja 🚗 Alicante

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Granada, a city with an unmistakably Moorish flavour, located in eastern Andalusia. You will visit the [Alhambra] (optional), a beautiful complex of buildings and gardens. The Alhambra, also known as the Red Fort, located in the Sierra Nevada mountains outside Granada. It was the largest political and aristocratic centre of the Moslem West. The palace grounds comprise beautiful rectangular courtyards and numerous fountains, as well as the Nasrid buildings that served as living quarters for the monarchs and their servants. Afterwards, visit the romantic [Pink Lake Of Torrevieja]. Overnight in Alicante or nearby.

## Day 6 Alicante Calpe Valencia



### Tour Overview

After breakfast along the [Alicante Beach], head to the [Castillo de Santa Barbara], a medieval Spanish fortress that sits on the Alicante Bay with unparalleled views of the entire Tabarca Island on a clear day. Afterwards, go to Calpe, where there is a [Redwall Apartments] (exterior visit only), climb the [Calpe Giant Rock], to enjoy the magnificent White Coast. On the way to the rock, you will pass by the Flamingo Habitat Lake, where you may see flamingos. Then go to Valencia, although it follows the excitement and joy of Spain, it does not have the busy rhythm of a big city. Sightseeing in the old town, such as [Valencia City Hall Square], [Plaça de la Verge] and [City of Arts and Sciences]. Overnight in Valencia or nearby.

## Day 7 Valencia Barcelona




### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will go to Barcelona, a city overlooking the Mediterranean Sea, and famous for Gaudí and other Art Nouveau architecture. [The Sagrada Família] is a one-of-a-kind basilica, the fruit of the work of genius architect Antoni Gaudí. Today, construction continues on the Basilica. [Casa Milà], a block of flats, is Gaudí's most iconic secular building and also his final residential project.
