Next, head to Córdo ba where you will visit several key landmarks: the [Roman Bridge], offering sc enic views of the Guadalquivir River and the city. You will also explore [Alley of Flowers], a narrow street adorned with colorful flowerpots and typical And alusian architecture. Finally, visit the [Córdoba Cathedral](exterior visit only), a magnificent blend of Islamic and Christian architectural styles. Overnight st ay in Cordoba.
