On the day of your scheduled tour, we will pick you up from your chosen bus stop or hotel in Reykjavík and embark on an unforgettable adventure throug h Iceland's most famous route – the Golden Circle. [Thingvellir National Park] One of the most remarkable natural wonders in the world is located at Thing vellir National Park, where visitors can witness the results of two drifting tect onic plates: the North American and Eurasian one. "Thingvellir" translates t o "Parliament Plains" .This makes the park an essential destination for thos e interested in Icelandic culture and history. [Bruarfoss Waterfall] This waterf all is truly a hidden gem located into Iceland's secret breathtaking landscape s, often referred to as "Iceland' s Bluest Waterfall". [Geyser Geothermal Area] The Geysir geothermal area hosts many powerful hot springs. Among them is Strokkur, a geyser that shoots up to 35 meters every 5-10 minutes. [Gullfos s Waterfall] The melting water of Langjökull, Iceland's second-largest glacier, cascades into a deep canyon to create the awe-inspiring "Golden Falls." On cl ear days, you can even catch a glimpse of Langjökull in the distance, with the mist from the waterfall creating a beautiful rainbow effect. This is an ideal sp ot for a breathtaking photo opportunity! [Kerid Volcano Crater] Kerid is a vol canic crater known for its vibrant contrast of colours. The approximately 6.50 0-year-old volcanic crater in South Iceland is undoubtedly the perfect Golden Circle detour. Back To Reykjavík Our return to the Reykjavík capital area is pl anned for approximately 5 pm; however, the schedule order and return time may be subject to changes based on weather and road conditions.

[Geysir Geyser]

Geysir, sometimes known as The Great Geysir, is a geyser in south-western Iceland, that geological studies suggest started forming about 1150 CE.

[Gullfoss Waterfall]

The name Gullfoss means "Golden Falls," and it's known for its powerful cascade. Gullfoss is fed by the Hvita River and plunges into a dramatic canyon, creating two distinct drops that total around 105 feet (32 meters) in height.
