Tour Overview

Visit two emblematic medieval Spanish cities in one day. Admire the medieval walls in Ávila and discover the history behind many of its most important sights. In Segovia, you can have free time and stroll Segovia on your own; include a guided tour with access to its spectacular Alcazar or add a gastronomic lunch that will delight your palate to this guided tour with Alcázar. Check in at our office in central Madrid 15 minutes in advance of your tour. Leave the city towards Ávila aboard one of our air-conditioned coaches. Our first stop for the day will be at the city of Ávila, one of the best-preserved fortifications in Spain. Follow your guide on a walking tour of the Old Town to discover the impressive history of this city. See Romanesque style churches, Gothic palaces and a fortified cathedral of the Middle Ages. Visit the Walls of Ávila and imagine the stories they have seen through the centuries. Marvel at the fortification and towers, which have granted the city a World Heritage Site status by UNESCO. We will continue the tour to Segovia. On arrival, we will divide in different groups. If you have chosen the option to visit Segovia at your own pace, you will have approximately three hours of free time. If you have chosen the option with monuments, you'll have approximately one hour of free time to have lunch on your own. The rest of the group will go to the restaurant to enjoy a lunch with roast suckling pig. After lunch, those who have chosen the tour with monuments will meet again with the guide to start the tour in Segovia. Walk through the old Jewish quarter of the city, visit the outside of the Cathedral and walk towards the Alcazar of Segovia. Enjoy a guided tour inside the castle and marvel at this spectacular fortification. If you have visited Segovia on your own, meet the rest of the group at the agreed time to return to Madrid.

LA MURALLA DE ÁVILA More than 1 km from the magnificent 12th-century city walls of Avila, this wall is divided into two parts by the cathedral, consisting of 2,500 small towers and 88 towers, which can be regarded as the best preserved wall in Spain. One.

[Segovia Castle]

Alcazar Castle is located in the western end of Segovia, Spain. The Segovia Castle, built on the cliff, has excellent views due to strategic considerations. The entrance has a moat more than 10 meters deep to prevent the enemy from attacking. The fort's first historical record dates back to the Christian literature of the 12th century. In 1862, the entire building was built on the original site after being destroyed by fire. In the castle, traces of Moorish culture are everywhere, and in many rooms it is often seen that the complex decorations that are common in the Moorish culture painted on the background of plaster in bright colors. After centuries of continuous renovation, the entire castle has now become a classical building that integrates palace architecture and military defense architecture. The castle in the Disney cartoon "Snow White" and "Sleeping Beauty" is the prototype of this castle.

[Acueducto de Segovia]

Acueducto de Segovia, which is 7 to 29 meters above the ground, has always been responsible for carrying water from the Acebeda River outside the city to the city for about 30,000 residents to drink. In addition to its function as a landmark, Acueducto de Segovia also has an impact on the tourist value of the city. As one of the best-preserved ferries in Europe, it is like a doorway across time and space, through which you can walk back to the ancient Roman period of 2,000 years ago, filled with ancient buildings and celebrating the wisdom of the ancient Romans for generations to come.
