### Day 1 Frankfurt 🚆 Heidelberg 🚆 Hohenzollern Castle 🏰 Southern Town



#### Tour Overview

Departure from Frankfurt and head towards Heidelberg. We'll visit [Heidelberg Castle] (included in the price), renowned for its stunning architecture and rich cultural heritage. You can also cross the [Old Bridge] and walk uphill, following the Philosopher's Path on the opposite bank of the Neckar River. As you stroll, you'll be delighted to see how the city, castle, river, and surrounding hills come together in a breathtakingly picturesque scene. Afterwards, continue to [Hohenzollern Castle] (included in the price), the ancestral seat of the Prussian royal family, renowned for its fairy-tale appearance. Overnight stay in a southern town of Germany. \*If Hohenzollern Castle is closed or inaccessible due to weather conditions or other factors, the visit will be limited to viewing the exterior.

## Day 2 Southern Town Neuschwanstein Castle Oberammergau Southern Town



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Germany to visit [Neuschwanstein Castle], one of the most famous castles in the world. On the left side of the castle lies the crystal-clear Alpsee Lake, while on the right, you will find the smaller Swan Lake. The [Marienbrücke (Mary's Bridge)] offers a spectacular view, spanning across a deep gorge and waterfall, and connecting the southern hills of the castle. Next, travel to the picturesque village of [Oberammergau], known for its stunning murals and traditional Bavarian culture. Visit the [Passion Play Theatre], where the famous Passion Play has been performed every ten years since the 17th century. You will also visit the [St. Peter and Paul Church], a beautiful baroque-style church known for its intricate decorations. Overnight in a southern town of Germany.

## Day 3 Southern town Königssee Munich



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, depart for Lake Königssee. Enjoy a scenic [boat ride] (Included in the price), with a stop at the picturesque [St. Bartholomew's Church]. The church, located on a small peninsula, is known for its striking red domes and beautiful setting amidst the mountains. Next, head to the Bavarian capital, Munich, for a city tour. Begin at [Marienplatz], the central square, where you can admire the impressive [New and Old Town Halls] (exterior visit only). Then, visit the [BMW World] and the [BMW Museum] (Included in the price), offering an immersive journey through BMW's history, cutting-edge innovations, and a showcase of their latest vehicles. Overnight in Munich or nearby.

## Day 4 Munich 🚆 Rothenburg 🚆 Würzburg



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Rothenburg, where you'll take a leisurely stroll through the Old Town. Visit the [Rothenburg Town Hall], an example of medieval architecture with its impressive façade. Then, explore the [St.Jakob's Church], known for its beautiful Gothic design and the famous altar. Continue to the [Rothenburg City Walls], which offer a glimpse into the city's historical defense structures. Next, travel to Würzburg. Before even reaching the city, you'll be captivated by its art, architecture, and vineyards. You have the option to visit a local winery for a wine tasting, where you can savor the flavors of German wines and immerse yourself in the charm of old-world Germany. Overnight in Würzburg or nearby.

## Day 5 Würzburg 🚆 Dresden



### Tour Overview

Today, we will embark on a tour of Dresden, visiting the Frauenkirche, originally built in the 18th century, which is a symbol of Dresden's resilience. It was completely destroyed during World War II and later rebuilt. Next, we'll visit the Zwinger Palace (included in the price), one of the most famous landmarks in Dresden. The Zwinger is a magnificent example of Baroque architecture. Finally, we'll have an exterior visit to the Semper Opera House, known for its exquisite architecture and world-class. Overnight in Dresden or nearby.

## Day 6 Dresden 🚗 Potsdam 🚗 Berlin



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, depart for Potsdam to visit [Sanssouci Palace] (Included in the price). This magnificent palace, once the summer residence of Frederick the Great, is famous for its Rococo architecture and beautifully landscaped gardens. Next, head to Germany's capital, Berlin. Explore the [Berlin Cathedral](Exterior visit only), a stunning baroque-style church with a large dome and rich history. Continue your tour with a view of [Museum Island](Exterior visit only), home to several world-renowned museums, showcasing treasures from ancient civilizations. Next, see the towering [Berlin TV Tower](Exterior visit only), one of the tallest structures in Europe. Finally, visit the historic [Berlin Wall], the barrier that once divided East and West Berlin during the Cold War. Several remnants of the Wall still stand, serving as a powerful reminder of the city's divided past. Overnight in Berlin or nearby.

## Day 7 Berlin 🚗 Lübeck 🚗 Hamburg



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, depart for Lübeck to visit [St. Mary's Church], a brick Gothic church, one of Lübeck's main landmarks. Next, head to Hamburg, where you will visit [Hamburg City Hall], which offers a fascinating glimpse into the city's political and historical past. Not far away is [Alster Lake], a picturesque spot in the center of Hamburg, the lake offers a serene atmosphere. Next, explore [Salzspeicher], a UNESCO World Heritage site, known for its historic red-brick warehouses, canals, and cobblestone streets. Finally, visit [Miniatur Wunderland] (Included in the price), the world's largest model railway exhibition, featuring incredibly detailed miniature landscapes and cities. Overnight in Hamburg or nearby.

Conclude the day with a scenic view of the Rhine River from the [Hohenzollern Bridge], famous for its love locks and breathtaking vistas. Overnight in Cologne or nearby.

## Day 9 Cologne 🚆 Koblenz 🚆 Rudesheim 🚆 Frankfurt

### Tour Overview

At the famous Deutsches Eck, or German Corner, where the Rhine and Moselle converge, lies one of Germany's oldest and most beautiful cities: Koblenz. Vineyards, forests and our mountain ranges form the unique backdrop to this 2,000-year-old city. We will stroll around the [Old Town] and visit the [Deutsches Eck]. Then we will go along the Rhine river valley to the "wine town" , [Rudesheim], on the right bank of the Rhine river. You will find overlapping red roofs and streets shaded by green trees in this town immersing in the fragrance of flowers and sunshine. We will take a walk on the pedestrian street in the old town and visit the old churches, and then take a [cruise ship] (Included in the price) to have a sightseeing over the Rhine river. After that we will go back to Frankfurt to end the tour.
