## Day 1 Helsinki Stockholm (Overnight on cruise)

After gathering in the morning, we will proceed to [Parliament Square] and then visit to the [Helsinki Cathedral], a prominent landmark in the city. Subsequently, we will proceed to [Sibelius Park], named in honour of the renowned Finnish musician. The park features a striking monument comprising over 600 stainless steel pipes, evoking the grandeur of a grand organ. Then we will experience the tranquility and depth of the [Tempeliaukio Church] (Included in the price). We will also have the opportunity to observe the [Kauppatori] and experience the local Finnish culture. In the evening, we will set sail on a cruise to Stockholm, where we will spend the night on the ship.

## Day 2 Stockholm

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, arrive in Stockholm at about 10:00. A visit to the [Old Town of Stockholm] offers the opportunity to experience the narrow cobblestone streets and the distinctive aroma of strong coffee. [The Vasa Museum] (Included in the price) provides visitors with the chance to learn about the history of this century-old ship. Then you will have the opportunity to visit the Swedish Royal Palace. If lucky, you may also witness the changing of the guard (changing time: 12:15 p.m., approximately 30 minutes). In the afternoon, visit [Stockholm City Hall](Included in the price). The Blue Hall is the venue for the Nobel Prize banquet. You may also take the [Stockholm Cruise](optional) to appreciate the city from a different perspective. Overnight in Stockholm.

## Day 3 Stockholm Karlstad Oslo

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to Karlstad, taking the scenic route along [Lake Vänern].Lake Vänern is located in southern Sweden, between the cities of Vänersborg and Karlstad. Then we crossed the border and arrived in Oslo, the capital of Norway. We will visit the [Vigeland Park] in Oslo. The park houses over 600 human sculptures, which represent the culmination of sculptor Gustav Vigeland's 20 years of dedicated work.. The sculptures focus on the theme of "life". Subsequently, we will proceed to [Oslo Opera House](Exterior visit only). The exterior lines are straightforward yet demonstrate a clear design sensibility. Overnight in Oslo.

## Day 4 Oslo Gothenburg

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to [Oslo City Hall], where we will view the magnificent building and the beautiful relief murals in the hall. The site also features a number of sculptures illustrating various aspects of Norwegian life. Furthermore, it is one of the venues used to award the Nobel Prize. The [Oslo Royal Palace](exterior visit only) offers visitors the opportunity to gain insight into the rich historical monuments of Norway in the 19th century. The [Akershus Fortress], situated by the sea, provides a vantage point from which to appreciate the entire Oslo cityscape. Overnight in Gothenburg.

## Day 5 Gothenburg Copenhagen

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to Gothenburg, a harbour city. We will visit [Gothenburg Cathedral], located on a hilltop, and then head to Götaplatsen Square, where various grand entertainment events are often held. The fountain in the center of the square features the [Statue of Poseidon], the Greek god of the sea, created by the Swedish sculptor Milles. Next, we will travel to Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark, to see the bronze Little Mermaid Statue at [Langelinie Pier Park]. The itinerary also includes visits to Denmark's primary royal residence, the classical [Amalienborg Palace] (exterior visit only), and the vibrant [Nyhavn] district. Overnight stay in Copenhagen.

## Day 6 Copenhagen North Zealand Karlshamn Klaipeda (Overnight on the cruise)

After breakfast, drive to [North Zealand] and visit [Frederiksborg Castle](exterior visit only), a Renaissance-style castle, is surrounded by stunning gardens, offering a picturesque view from the exterior. Then, explore [Kronborg Castle](included in the price), a UNESCO World Heritage site famously known as the setting for Shakespeare's Hamlet. Afterward, head to Karlshamn, where you'll board a cruise to Klaipeda, spending the night aboard the cruise. (Cruise reference time: 19:00-09:00)

Then, we will head to Tallinn, the capital of Estonia, which is one of Northern Europe's best-preserved medieval cities and was added to UNESCO's World Heritage list in 1997. As part of the influential Hanseatic League, Tallinn was home to wealthy merchants who left their mark on the city's architecture. The city's iconic skyline is dotted with church spires and red-roofed towers. You can wander the streets of [Old Town] and marvel at buildings dating back to the Middle Ages.
