Tour Overview

Depart from Paris and head to Geneva, "The City of Watchmaking". We will visit [Lake Geneva], a crescent-shaped lake bordered by both Switzerland and France, we'll explore [Palais des Nations], the European headquarters of the United Nations. Finally, discover [Flower Clock], which is made entirely of flowers and symbolizes Geneva's long tradition of watchmaking. Overnight in Geneva or nearby.

Day 2 Geneva 🚆 Montreux 🚆 Zweisimmen 🚆 Bern



Tour Overview

After breakfast, depart for Montreux and visit [Chillon Castle] (Included in the price), This medieval fortress sits on the shores of Lake Geneva and is famous worldwide for inspiring British poet Byron's renowned poem "The Prisoner of Chillon." Next, board the [Golden Pass Train] (Included in the price), this train journey offers breathtaking views of the Swiss countryside, passing through rolling hills, charming villages, and majestic mountains as you travel from Montreux to Zweisimmen. From Zweisimmen, continue your journey to Bern, the Swiss capital. Take a leisurely walk through the [Old Town], a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stroll along the Aare River for stunning views and enjoy the tranquil atmosphere of this charming city. Overnight in Bern or nearby.

Day 3 Bern 🚆 Interlaken 🚆 Brienzensee 🚆 Swiss town



Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Interlaken. Enjoy a leisurely stroll through the town and take a boat cruise (cost included) to admire [Lake Brienz]. Next, we'll visit the Top of Europe—[Jungfrau]. For more than 100 years, the Jungfrau Railway has been making its journey to Europe's highest-altitude railway station, located at 3,454 meters. Throughout the year, the cog railway travels steeply through a tunnel to Jungfrau from Kleine Scheidegg. One stop inside the tunnel offers spectacular views of the glacier world outside, visible through windows in the Eiger North Face. At the summit, we are greeted by a high-Alpine wonderland made of ice, snow, and rock. All of this can be marvelled at from the viewing platforms "Sphinx" and "Plateau" on the Aletsch Glacier, or from the "Ice Palace." You can also [take a paragliding tandem flight] (available only April-October) and enjoy a bird's-eye view of the fascinating winter landscape of the Swiss Alps. Here, you can experience a unique perspective of the majestic Jungfrau and the charming town of Interlaken. *During the suspension of the Lake Brienz cruise, we will instead experience a Lake Lucerne cruise.

Day 4 Swiss town 🚗 Lungern 🚗 Lucerne 🚗 Zurich



Tour Overview

After breakfast, depart for a visit to [Lungern], a picturesque village nestled beside the serene Lake Lungern, surrounded by stunning Alpine mountains. Then, head to Lucerne [Old Town] to admire the [Lion Monument], a poignant tribute to the Swiss Guards who died during the French Revolution, and the [Chapel Bridge], a covered wooden bridge that is a symbol of Lucerne's rich history. Next, travel to Zurich, where you will see the [Grossmünster Church](exterior visit only), take in the views of [Lake Zurich], and stroll along [Bahnhofstrasse], one of the world's most exclusive shopping streets. Overnight in Zurich or nearby.

Tour Overview

Today, we will have a full day of sightseeing in Colmar, a charming medieval town in northeastern France, known for its well-preserved half-timbered houses, picturesque canals, and vibrant, flower-lined streets, often referred to as the "Venice of the Alps." Stroll through the town and immerse yourself in its unique atmosphere, allowing your mind and body to relax. Overnight in Strasbourg or nearby.

After breakfast, begin your exploration of Strasbourg, a city rich in history and culture. Start by visiting the [Strasbourg Cathedral], a masterpiece of Gothic architecture, renowned for its breathtaking facade and impressive astronomical clock. Next, take a leisurely stroll along the [Ill River], which winds through the heart of the city, passing traditional timber-framed houses that reflect the city's medieval charm. Finally, wander through the picturesque [La Petite France district]. Known for its narrow cobblestone streets and half-timbered houses, this charming area once housed fishermen, millers, and tanners. After that, we return to Paris and the trip ends.
