**Tour Overview** 

After breakfast, head to Interlaken. Enjoy a leisurely stroll through the town and take a b oat cruise (cost included) to admire [Lake Brienz]. Next, we'll visit the Top of Europe—[Ju ngfraujoch]. For more than 100 years, the Jungfrau Railway has been making its journey to Europe's highest-altitude railway station, located at 3,454 meters. Throughout the year, the cog railway travels steeply through a tunnel to Jungfraujoch from Kleine Scheidegg. One stop inside the tunnel offers spectacular views of the glacier world outside, visible through windows in the Eiger North Face. At the summit, we are greeted by a high-Alpin e wonderland made of ice, snow, and rock. All of this can be marvelled at from the viewing platforms "Sphinx" and "Plateau" on the Aletsch Glacier, or from the "Ice Palace." You can also [take a paragliding tandem flight] (available only April-October) and enjoy a bird's-eye view of the fascinating winter landscape of the Swiss Alps. Here, you can experience a unique perspective of the majestic Jungfrau and the charming town of Interlaken. \*During the suspension of the Lake Brienz cruise, we will instead experience a Lake Lucerne cruise.
