The Golden Mountain Express connects the ancient city of Lucerne in the Germanspeaking part of Central Switzerland and the elegant lakeside city of Montreux in the French-speaking southwest. Bright lakes, majestic Alps, laid-back ranch, beautiful vineyards – you can enjoy the colorful scenery.

The Golden Pass Express is a combination of MOB (Zweismen to Montreux), BLS (Interlaken to Zweissee) and Brunig (Luxembourg to Interlaken).


