Day 1 Paris  Vaux le Vicomte  Fontainebleau  Paris

Tour Overview

Sett off from our meeting point in the center of Paris at 9:15am for the first stop of the day : Fontainebleau castle. After an 1 hour and 15 min ride you will enter the forest of Fontainebleau to directly get to the impressive castle. Fontainebleau is the only royal and imperial château to have been continuously inhabited for seven centuries. During your audio guide visit, explore the richly furnished château, its unique collections, and key pieces such as the throne of Napoleon I and the famous horseshoe-shaped staircase. You will also visit the château's spacious private apartments, which enjoyed all the comforts of the age. After the tour, explore the vast park surrounding the château on your own, as well as its three picturesque gardens. You can then have lunch freely on the lawns or at the restaurant on the site of Fontainebleau. At the beginning of the afternoon, we will leave for Vaux-le-Vicomte for the second part of the tour, which is only 45min away. Vaux le Vicomte inspired King Louis XIV to build Versailles. By following the audio guided route, you will discover Nicolas Fouquet's private apartments, the state rooms, and the château's great kitchens and vaulted cellars. The commentaries offer you an incredible experience with 3D sound that gives your visit to the castle a whole new dimension. Throughout the rooms, you will plunge into the heart of the Fouquet affair, during which you will hear significant figures such as Molière or Louis XIV. Enjoy the access to the dome of Vaux le Vicomte to contemplate the superb view over the castle park. Also take time to stroll in the splendid French garden of the 35-hectare estate with its sculpted shrubs, water features and splendid multicoloured flowerbeds. Departure from Vaux le Vicomte is scheduled for 5pm for an arrival around 6:30pm in the center of Paris.

Notice:

2. This tour will not provide information about the tour leader and vehicle, and **the tour leader will not contact the guests**, so the guests need to take the initiative to find the vehicle and board the tour.
3. This tour must arrive at the meeting point 15 minutes in advance and take the initiative to look for the corresponding vehicle, the bus departs on time, no waiting. Late or lost in the middle of the leader can only call the official phone communication to catch up with the group.

[Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte]

Similar to the practice of the Langham House, the Woyj Castle is also the center of gravity of the oval hall at the entrance. The classical column (pillar) is used on the façade, and the pilaster at the entrance has a vertical image (similar to the ancient Egyptian figure column). The round tiger window on the façade is a large appearance. Like the Langham House, the baroque interior of the building is superb. The huge garden of the Viscount Castle is an important work in the Baroque Court and has a major influence on the future Versailles Palace.

[Private Tour_Palace of Fontainebleau]

The Palace of Fontainebleau is a magnificent palace in France. It was built in 1137 and is located in the southeast of Paris. It was mainly used for the residence, picnic and temporary hunting of the emperors of the past dynasties. The building complex of the Palace of Fontainebleau consists of castles, palaces, courtyards and gardens. Among the halls that are open all year round are three Renaissance halls, the emperor's bedroom and the Napoleon Museum. From the perspective of architectural art, the Palace of Fontainebleau can be said to be one of the masterpieces of French classical architecture, and the architectural styles of various periods have left traces here. If you just want to experience the beauty and sophistication of a French court, it is recommended to visit Fontainebleau. It's not as crowded as Versailles, but it has the same refined look of a French court. Fontainebleau originally means beautiful spring water, and the translation name of Fontainebleau comes from Xu Zhimo.
