Day 1 Paris Giverny Paris

Tour Overview

Take advantage of this half-day excursion to discover the Giverny Foundation in complete freedom. The departure is from the center of Paris (8:15a.m.), where you will be given the QR code for the audio-guide mobile application for the visit. After about an hour and a half drive through the green countryside, you will arrive in Giverny (9:45a.m.). You will then have about 2 hours to discover Monet's house, his studio and his gardens of a thousand colors. Claude Monet lived in this Norman village for more than forty years with all his family. You will be able to immerse yourself in Monet's daily life by visiting his house, which includes the "petit salon bleu" (small blue living room), which was the reading room, the latter overlooking the "grocery store" where tea, oil, spices and eggs were stored, the dining room, which exhibits one of the most important collections of Japanese prints in the world, and his private apartments. You can continue your visit with a walk in the sumptuous garden of Giverny which was the main source of inspiration for this undisputed master of impressionism. During your stroll, you will be able to listen to the commentaries offered by your audio-guide on the life, work and works of Monet. You will admire the central alley surrounded by roses and nasturtiums, the flower beds of all kinds that offer a wide range of colors. You will cross the Clos Normand where multiple oriental plants are planted. You will walk through the magnificent water garden with the famous water lilies on the pond, the weeping willows and the famous Japanese bridge crossing the pond. 11:45 Return to Paris. 13:15 Arrival in Paris, end of trip.

Monet's Garden is located 88 kilometers northwest of Paris, in the Haute-Normandie department. In 1883, Monet was attracted by this place when he passed by by train, so he moved here. For 43 years, Monet spent half of his life here, creating countless works. Monet called himself "the garden is my most beautiful work". Today, 85 years after Monet left, this place is still maintained in the same way as Monet lived. From tulips when the park opens in April, to the most famous water lilies in midsummer, and chrysanthemums before closing in October, you can find the colors in Monet's paintings here.
