Day 1 Paris Monet's Garden Versailles Paris




Tour Overview

Take your seat aboard an air-conditioned tour bus departing at 8:15 a.m. You'll be driven to the Fondation Claude Monet. See Giverny at your own pace, starting with Monet's home. There, you will learn about the life of the artist, who lived there until his death at the age of 43. Next, turn on your audio guide for commentary as you visit Monet's garden. Amble through flower-lined paths that inspired the artist's impressionist paintings. Revel in the lavish, multicolored flower beds. Step into the Clos-Normand, home to many Far Eastern plants and vegetation. Cross the water garden by the Japanese bridge. Peer over the edge to see its famous water lilies, found in the celebrated painting of the same name. Take your time as you experience Monet's universe in an exotic, ethereal atmosphere. Next, climb aboard your bus. It will take you to the Moulin de Fourges or the Bistrot du Moulin restaurant, 10 minutes from Giverny, where you will be served a lunch that includes traditional Normand fare. After the meal, it's off to the Palace of Versailles. Priority access lets you get the most out of your Versailles visit. Your audio commentary will point you in the right direction as you discover the King's chambers. You will depart Versailles around 5:00 p.m. for an arrival in Paris at around 5:45 p.m.

2. When leaving the entrance of Giverny Gardens, the tour operator will receive an audio guide

Notice:

1. The buses with **[Paris City Vision]** printed on the body and wearing red vests with **[Paris City Vision]** printed on the back are staff members. There may be more than one bus parked at the meeting point. Upon arrival at the meeting point, **please take the initiative to look for the corresponding bus to join the tour.** If you are not sure, please ask the staff for help.
2. This tour will not provide information about the tour leader and vehicle, and **the tour leader will not contact the guests**, so the guests need to take the initiative to find the vehicle and board the tour.
3. This tour must arrive at the meeting point 15 minutes in advance and take the initiative to look for the corresponding vehicle, the bus departs on time, no waiting. Late or lost in the middle of the leader can only call the official phone communication to catch up with the group.
4. The time and location of the tour will be based on the confirmation received, please use Google Maps to search.

Monet Gardens and Former Residence

[Versailles Palace]

One of the world's five major palaces, in this legendary palace of extravagance, the golden gates are magnificent. The palatial interior is extremely luxurious, and the hall is still stunning, with cultural relics that carry centuries of history and loneliness, and people remember the old days in the settled dust.

[Monet Gardens and Former Residence]

Monet Garden - Half of Monet's life has been spent here, creating countless books. Monet claimed that "the garden is my most beautiful work." Fully show the post-impressionism here. Since Monet's death, it has been maintained in the same way as Monet's life. In the former residence, the remains of Monet's life have been preserved as well. At the same time, you will find that Monet was obsessed with the art of Japanese ukiyo-e, and the underground passages of the colorful gardens and bamboo groves were excavated by the owner. Together, in the Gion, you can find that the Japanese Bridge echoes in the Lily Pond! Beautiful ~ colorful ~, Monet Garden will let you call the master of photography - every photo in your hand is a colorful and beautiful painting!
