### Day 1 Oslo Heddal Stavanger




#### Tour Overview

Depart from the Oslo at 8:30 AM (leaving the hotel at 8:00 AM) and head towards Stavanger. On the way, stop at Heddal to visit Norway's largest stave church — the [Heddal Stave Church], it has the impressive appearance of a wooden cathedral. The building is constructed of ore-pine timber. During catholic times this church was dedicated to St Mary. Continue on to Stavanger, enjoying the beautiful scenery of Norway's largest national park, the [Hardangervidda Plateau], along the way. Overnight in Stavanger or nearby.

## Day 2 Stavanger Lysefjorden Stavanger

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### Tour Overview

Following breakfast, we will depart from Stavanger to [Lysefjorden], take the bus to the Preikestolen car park, and then start hiking to [Preikestolen] (Pulpit Rock). It rises 604 meters above Lysefjord in Ryfylke and is one of Norway's biggest attractions. The view from the top is stunning (The round trip takes a pproximately 7-8 hours. If you don't go to Pulpit Rock, you can choose to have a free day in Stavanger instead). Overnight in Stavanger or nearby.

### Note:

1. The mountain road is rugged, so it is recommended to bring shoes suitable for hiking;
  2. The weather in the fjord area is unpredictable, so it is best to bring a raincoat;
  3. There are no shops along the way, so it is recommended to bring bottled water and lunch;
  4. Those who are afraid of heights should not get close to the edge of the pulpit;

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## Day 3 Stavanger Bergen

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### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to [Bergen], Norway' s second-largest city, which is a historic coastal gem in Fjord Norway. Framed by seven mountains and iconic fjords like the Sognefjord and Hardangerfjord, it's the perfect base for exploring Norway's breathtaking fjord landscapes. You can take the [Fløibanen funicular] to reach Mount Fløyen, where you can enjoy a panoramic view of Bergen and the region. Subsequently, we will proceed to the [Bryggen Ancient City], an invaluable example of Nordic wooden architecture, and explore the vibrant [Fish Market in Bergen], which has, since the 1200s, been a meeting place for merchants and fishermen. You can find fresh fish and seafood, as well as local farm food like fruit, berries, and vegetables. Overnight in Bergen or nearby.

## Day 4 Bergen 🚆 Gudvangen 🚆 Flam 🚆 fjord town



### Tour Overview

This morning, head to [Gudvangen]. You' ll board a cruise to sail through Aurlandsfjord into the World Heritage-listed Nærøyfjord, the narrowest fjord in all of Europe. This is perhaps the most beautiful arm of [Sognefjord], with its mighty waterfalls and small farms clinging to the steep mountainsides. You' ll also board the train and enjoy an exciting ride on the scenic [Flåm Railway] between Flam and Myrdal. Overnight in Fjord Town.

## Day 5 Fjord Town 🚆 Fjærland 🚆 Ålesund 🚆 Fjord Town



### Tour Overview

The most easily accessible and most spectacular of the glacier arms on the Jostedalsglacier is the [Bøyabreen Glacier] in Fjærland. Bøyabreen Glacier is steep and prone to ice erosion and has its highest point above 1,700 meters above sea level. and lowest point approx. 600 m. Next, go to visit the [Norwegian Glacier museum], which is the leading centre in Norway for dissemination of knowledge with regard to glaciers and climate. The building has received several awards, including the highest Norwegian award for architecture. Subsequently, we will visit [Ålesund]. Ålesund is beautifully situated on several islands stretching out into the Atlantic Ocean. Many use this Art Nouveau city as a starting point to explore the renowned Geirangerfjord UNESCO World Heritage site. Overnight at the Fjord town.

## Day 6 Fjord Town 🚌 The Atlantic Road 🚌 The Eagle Road 🚌 Fossbergom



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to visit two of Norway's most renowned scenic routes: the [Atlantic Road] and [Eagle Road]. The Atlantic road is a unique stretch of road which takes you right out to the ocean's edge, and is known to be the world's most beautiful drive. It connects Averøy with the mainland via a series of small islands and islets. Ørnevegen –Eagle Road – is the name given to the steepest stretch of road up the mountain side from Geiranger towards Eidsdal. The road was called Eagle Road because at its highest point it passed through terrain that had traditionally been the domain of a large number of eagles. Overnight in Fossbergom or nearby. Note: Due to road construction along the Eagle's Road leading to the Geirangerfjord, the itinerary may be restricted. If the visit to Eagle's Road and the viewpoint cannot be completed, the tour will be replaced with a visit to the Trollstigen Camping.

## Day 7 Fossbergom 🚌 Lillehammer 🚌 Oslo



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to [Lillehammer] – in the heart of Norway – is the ideal holiday destination for anyone in search of amazing adventures in the great outdoors. Immerse yourself in Norwegian cultural history at [Maihaugen Museum]. Maihaugen is the largest open-air museum in Norway with more than 200 historic houses from the 13th century until today. In the idyllic open-air museum there are more than 200 historic houses from as far back as the 13th Century until today. It is nice to stroll around and get an impression of how we lived in the past. Following the conclusion of the excursion, we will go directly to Oslo Airport, with an estimated arrival time of 15:00.
