Day 1 Reykjavik 🚌 Golden Circle 🚌 Vik



Tour Overview

The tour departs from Reykjavik in the morning and visits on the Golden Circle. [Pingvellir National Park] is the only location on the Icelandic mainland to hold UNESCO World Heritage status, and it is also the site of Iceland's ancient parliament. [The Geysir geyser] erupts every 1 to 2 minutes, gradually subsiding in between, creating a magnificent display. [Gullfoss (Golden Falls)] features two levels of cascading water. When the sun is out, the water droplets from the falls reflect a rainbow, giving the waterfall a golden brilliance—hence the name "Golden Falls." Overnight in Vik or nearby. Should weather conditions permit, the aurora will be visible near the hotel that night.

Day 2 Jökulsárlón Blue Ice Cave Vik



Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to [Jökulsárlón] and [Diamond Beach]. If the weather conditions are favorable, the sun will cast a shimmering reflection on the ice on the beach, resembling sparkling diamonds. Next, we will embark on an incredible journey up the glacier, where you'll enter the unique [Blue Ice Cave(optional)] (October to March). The ice cave is naturally formed, and its shape changes each year, which adds to its allure. During the summer months (May to September), we will instead experience the Glacier Lagoon [Amphibian Boat Tour(optional)]. Overnight stay in South Iceland. *Should weather conditions permit, the aurora may be visible near the hotel that night.

The blue ice cave is a rare natural phenomenon that is formed by nature. This stunning spectacle can only be observed during winter, when temperatures fall below freezing and the river water beneath the ice solidifies. Each year, unique caves with distinct characteristics emerge in various locations. Depending on prevailing conditions and safety considerations at that time, our itinerary will include a selective visit to one of these natural ice caves.

Day 3 Southern Town 🚗 South Coast 🚗 Reykjavik



Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will head to the [Eldhraun] lava field, which was formed by a volcanic eruption. We will also make a quick stop in [Vik], the southernmost town in Iceland. At the summit of the mountain in this town, you will find a small red-roofed church. Our next stop is the renowned [Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach], where the basalt columns on the beach provide a great photo opportunity. We then head to the [DC-3 wreckage]. Although the plane wreckage resulted from an aviation accident, the absence of casualties has led to the creation of one of the most distinctive non-natural landscapes in Iceland. Finally, we will visit the two major waterfalls in the south, [Seljalandsfoss] and [Skogafoss], where you can appreciate the magnificent beauty of the region.
