Then, we'll visit [Hallgrím skirkja Church], one of Iceland's most iconic landmarks, known for its unique modernist design and panoramic views of the city from its tower. Next, we'll explore [Perlan], an extraordinary building with a glass dome, and the impressive [Harpa Concert Hall], renowned for its geometric glass facade and vibrant cultural atmosphere. In the afternoon, we will head to the Blue Lagoon, where you can relax and unwind in its milky-blue hot springs. (We will also pick up guests arriving at the airport in the afternoon.) Overnight in Reykjavik.

Day 2 Reykjavik ■ Snaefellsnes ■ Reykjavik

Tour Overview

After breakfast, you' Il head to all the wonders that the Hidden Gem of the West, the Snæfellsnes Peninsula, has to offer. We will make our way to [Kirkj ufell], "The Church Mountain", and Kirkjufellfoss waterfall. This iconic narro w mountain has become the landmark of Snæfellsnes in recent years, especia lly after being featured as the "Arrowhead Mountain" in Game of Thrones. Next, we will visit [Lóndrangar], a pair of rock pinnacles in Iceland, which are remnants of a larger crater that has mostly eroded away. Looming over the e ntire southern coastline, the 75-meter high basalt pinnacles of Lóndrangar se t the tone for what' s to come. Then, we will visit the fishing village of [Arnar stapi]. Few places are as charming as this one, and here we will take a walk al ong the scenic coastline. You can enjoy lunch while taking in the beautiful sc enery. Just east of Arnarstapi, we will stop to admire [Búðakirkja], a 19th-cent ury church. Overnight in Reykjavík.

Tour Overview

We'll head out for a lovely drive along the Golden Circle: [Pingvellir National Park] is the only location on the Icelandic mainland to hold UNESCO World H eritage status, and it is also the site of Iceland's ancient parliament. [The Ge ysir geyser] erupts every 1 to 2 minutes, gradually subsiding in between, crea ting a magnificent display. [Gullfoss (Golden Falls)] features two levels of cas cading water. When the sun is out, the water droplets from the falls reflect a rainbow, giving the waterfall a golden brilliance—hence the name "Golden Falls." We will also visit to [Kerið crater lake], known for its vibrant green water and the striking colors of the crater on the surrounding hillside. Overnight in the south of Iceland. *Should weather conditions permit, the aurora may be v isible near the hotel that night.

Day 4 Southern Town ■ Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon ■ Blue Ice Cave or Glacier Lagoon Cruise ■ Southern Town

Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will proceed to [Jökulsárlón] and [Diamond Beach]. If the weather conditions are favorable, the sun will cast a shimmering reflection on the ice on the beach, resembling sparkling diamonds. Next, we will embark on an incredible journey up the glacier, where you'll enter the unique [Blue Ice Cave] (October to April). The ice cave is naturally formed, and its shape changes each year, which adds to its allure. During the summer months (May to September), we will instead experience the Glacier Lagoon [Amphibian Boat Tour]. Overnight stay in South Iceland. *Should weather conditions permit, the aurora may be visible near the hotel that night.

Day 5 Southern Town ■ South Coast ■ Reykjavik

Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will head to the [Eldhraun] lava field, which was formed by a volcanic eruption. We will also make a quick stop in [Vik], the southernm ost town in Iceland. At the summit of the mountain in this town, you will find a small red-roofed church. Our next stop is the renowned [Reynisfjara Black S and Beach], where the basalt columns on the beach provide a great photo o pportunity. We then head to the [DC-3 wreckage]. Although the plane wreck age resulted from an aviation accident, the absence of casualties has led to the creation of one of the most distinctive non-natural landscapes in Iceland. Finally, we will visit the two major waterfalls in the south, [Seljalandsfoss] and [Skogafoss], where you can appreciate the magnificent beauty of the region. **Drop Off *For reference only, the actual arrangement is subject to the to**


