## Day 1 Barcelona



### Tour Overview

Today, we'll visit Barcelona, a city overlooking the Mediterranean Sea and famous for its Gaudí architecture and other Art Nouveau masterpieces. We will visit the [Sagrada Familia Cathedral] (included in the price), the iconic landmark of Barcelona, and the only building in the world that has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site even before its completion. [Park Güell] (included in the price) is an exemplary work of garden design among Gaudí's many creations. Next, we will explore the [Casa Milà](included in the price), where every building, wrought-iron door, and balcony tells a unique story. We will then stroll along the lively [Las Ramblas], passing by the colorful [La Boqueria Market], and visit [Columbus Square] to experience the charm of the city.

## Day 2 Barcelona 🚆 Zaragoza 🚆 Madrid



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, proceed to Zaragoza. With more than 2,000 years of history, Zaragoza is known for its magnificent Basilica del Pilar, its Roman foundations, its cultural diversity, and the warmth of its people. [The Basilica of Nuestra Señora del Pilar] (included in the price) is the symbol of the city. Another must-see is the stunning [Aljafería Palace] (exterior visit only), originally built as a pleasure palace for the kings of the Taifa of Saraqusta. Overnight in Madrid or nearby.

## Day 3 Madrid 🚆 Segovia 🚆 Madrid



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will have sightseeing in Madrid, Madrid, cheerful and vibrant at all hours, is famous for being an open city. In addition to its famous museums, busy streets dotted with all kinds of shops, restaurants with world cuisine and unbeatable nightlife, Madrid will surprise you with its tranquil historic spots. Visit [Madrid Royal Palace] (Included in the price), [Plaza Mayor], [Puerta del Sol], [Gran Via] and [Santiago Bernabéu Stadium] (exterior visit only). In the afternoon, travel to Segovia and visit the spectacular [Roman Aqueduct], a stunning double-arched structure set in the middle of the magnificent old city, and a Gothic church [Segovia Main Church] (exterior visit only). Visit the [Segovia Castle] (exterior visit only), which is the prototype of the castle in the Disney animated films "Snow White" and "Sleeping Beauty". Overnight in Madrid or nearby.

## Day 4 Madrid 🚗 Toledo 🚗 Cordoba



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will head to one of the oldest cities in Europe: Toledo. The city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and has, throughout history, been an outstanding example of the peaceful coexistence of three cultures: Jewish, Christian, and Muslim. You will experience the mystery and depth of religion, and appreciate the medieval legacy of ancient architecture that continues to influence the city today. We will visit the [Toledo Old Town] and the [Toledo Cathedral] (exterior visit only). Overnight in Cordoba or nearby.

## Day 5 Cordoba 🚗 Granada



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Córdoba where you will visit several key landmarks: the [Roman Bridge], offering scenic views of the Guadalquivir River and the city. You will also explore [Alley of Flowers], a narrow street adorned with colorful flowerpots and typical Andalusian architecture. Finally, visit the [Córdoba Cathedral](exterior visit only), a magnificent blend of Islamic and Christian architectural styles. Next, set off for a visit to the [Alhambra Palace] (included in the price), also known as the "Red Fortress." This UNESCO World Heritage site is a prime example of Moorish architecture, with its beautiful gardens, intricate tilework, and breathtaking views over the city of Granada. Overnight stay in Granada.

\*Due to the high demand for the Alhambra and the limited number of tickets sold each day, especially for the Nasrid Palace, ticket availability is constrained by space limitations. On special dates when tickets are sold out, the guided tour will refund the price difference of 20 euros, or 10 euros if only the gardens are visited.

## Day 6 Granada Mijas Ronda Seville



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Mijas, wander through its charming narrow streets, lined with whitewashed buildings, and take in the spectacular views of the coast. Next stop is [Ronda], where you will stroll through the Old Town and visit the famous [Puente Nuevo (New Bridge)], an iconic structure that spans the El Tajo Gorge. You will also have the chance to see the [Bullring](exterior visit only), a site that marks Ronda's deep connection to bullfighting tradition. Finally, continue your journey to Seville. When in Seville, you can't miss Flamenco, as it is the birthplace of this passionate art form. You can enjoy a Flamenco performance at your own expense. Overnight in Seville or nearby.

## Day 7 Seville Évora



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will drive to the jewel of southern Spain - Seville, a historic city whose rise and fall encapsulate the story of the Spanish Empire. Upon arrival, we will visit [Plaza de España], featuring a large semicircular building, beautiful bridges, and a canal; [Real Alcázar de Sevilla](Included in the price), a royal palace originally developed by Moorish Muslim kings and [Catedral de Sevilla](Included in the price), the largest Gothic cathedral in the world. Overnight in Évora or nearby.

## Day 8 Évora Lisbon



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, travel to the historic city of Évora to visit [the Chapel of Bones] (included in the price), famous for its interior walls, which are lined with the bones and skulls of over 5,000 monks. Next, visit the Romanesque-Gothic cathedral [Évora Cathedral] (exterior visit only). In the afternoon, visit Lisbon, including [Belem Tower], [Monument to the Discoverers], and [Jerónimos Monastery] (exterior visit only). Overnight in Lisbon or nearby.

## Day 9 Lisbon Cabo da Roca Sintra Lisbon



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to [Cabo da Roca], located at the westernmost point of the European continent. "Where the land ends and the sea begins" is the description of this place. Then, head to Sintra to visit:[Sintra Royal Palace] (exterior visit only), a stunning blend of Gothic, Manueline, Moorish, and Renaissance architectural styles; [the Moorish Castle] (exterior visit only), built by the Moors during their occupation of the Iberian Peninsula; [Pena Palace], (Included in the price), the palace and its surrounding park are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Return to Lisbon, tour ends.
