Day 1 London Windsor Oxford London




Tour Overview

In the morning, depart from London to [Windsor Castle], a royal home and fortress for more than 900 years. It remains a working palace to this day and is the official residence of His Majesty The King. After lunch, visit Oxford, a city renowned for [Oxford University], which is steeped in British cultural heritage. Here, you'll find the [Ashmolean Museum] and [Trinity College], which produced three British prime ministers, as well as St. Mary's Church, the main church of Oxford University. If time permits, you can also visit the [Carfax Tower], located in the busiest area of Oxford, and the [Oxford University Museum], where Charles Darwin developed his theory of evolution. Additionally, don't miss [Radcliffe Square], a picturesque location often featured on Oxford postcards. We'll end today's tour around 16:00, Overnight near London or Oxford.

Day 2 London Cotswolds Shakespeare's Birthplace Manchester

Depart for the [Cotswolds], famous for its lush rolling pastures, picturesque stone villages, and winding rivers. This rural gem has graced countless books, artworks, and TV shows. Afterwards, travel to the town of [Stratford-upon-Avon], the birthplace and burial place of William Shakespeare. Visit [Shakespeare's Birthplace], the house where he spent his childhood, located in the heart of Stratford-upon-Avon. Discover stories of Shakespeare's family life. Overnight in Manchester or nearby.

If you want to relive the magic of childhood, head to the heart of the town to visit [The World of Beatrix Potter Attraction], a beloved fairy tale paradise that has become a British household name. Overnight in Glasgow or nearby.

Day 4 Glasgow 🚗 Scottish Highlands 🚗 Loch Ness 🚗 Scottish Town



Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to the stunning natural scenery of the [Scottish Highlands]. Visit the famous [Glencoe Glen] and the iconic [Three Sisters], then continue to enjoy the natural beauty along the way, passing by the United Kingdom's highest peak, Ben Nevis. Next, we will pass through the picturesque village of [Fort William] and arrive at [Fort Augustus], a medieval fortress on the shores of Loch Ness. Take in the breathtaking views of [Loch Ness]. Overnight stay in a Scottish town or nearby.

We will admire the magnificent [The Storr] and then arrive at the [Lealt Waterfall] and [Kilt Rock]. Overnight stay in a Scottish town.

Day 6 Scottish towns 🚗 Pitlochry 🚗 Edinburgh



Tour Overview

In the morning, we will leave for [Pitlochry], known for its stunning natural beauty, charming Victorian architecture. And then head to Edinburgh. Overlooking the entire city from [Edinburgh Castle] is a must-do when you visit. Afterwards, you will have some leisure time to explore on your own. Here are some recommendations: Stroll along the [Royal Mile]. Stop by the [Elephant Café], located on the corner of the street, where J.K. Rowling wrote parts of Harry Potter. Explore the bustling commercial streets of [Princes Street], which divides Edinburgh into the New Town and the Old Town. If you're interested, visit the [National Gallery of Scotland]. To the east, you can enjoy a peaceful walk in the [Princes Street Gardens]. From a distance, you can see [Calton Hill], which offers stunning views: on one side, the blue Atlantic Ocean, and on the other, a full view of Edinburgh Castle. If time allows, you can visit the slightly farther [Holyrood Palace], the Queen's summer residence. Finally, we will gather and head to the hotel for check-in and rest.

Day 7 Edinburgh 🚗 York



Tour Overview

Depart for [York], an ancient city with over 1,900 years of history. It seamlessly blends the cultures of different eras in Britain and serves as both a microcosm and a witness to British history. Explore the [York Minster], which have stood for more than 2,000 years, and walk along the ancient city walls. Don't miss [The Shambles], which served as the inspiration for Diagon Alley in the Harry Potter films. If time allows, you can also visit [Betty's Café Tea Rooms] for a traditional British afternoon tea, embracing the quaint, elegant charm of this historic town. For a relaxing experience, take a stroll along the River Ouse or explore the fascinating [National Railway Museum York]. Overnight in York or nearby.

Day 8 York 🚗 Cambridge 🚗 London



Tour Overview

Depart for Cambridge University, the renowned universities in the UK. Xu Zhimo's famous poem "Farewell to Cambridge" captures the essence of this historic institution. You can [take a punt] on the River Cam to enjoy the city from a unique perspective, or stroll through the colleges to soak in the rich cultural atmosphere. Visit [King's College], known for its stunning Gothic architecture, and see the apple tree at the entrance of [Trinity College]—said to be a descendant of the tree under which Newton had his famous inspiration. Don't miss the two iconic bridges spanning the River Cam: Newton's [Mathematical Bridge] and the [Bridge of Sighs], which connects St. John's College. After the tour, return to London and conclude your visit.
