In the morning, we will travel to Heidelberg, which is situated along the Neckar River. Here you will explore [Universität Heidelberg], Germany's oldest university, the majestic [Schloss Heidelberg], and the iconic [Alte Brücke Heidelberg], offering picturesque views of the city and the river. Stroll through the [Hauptstrasse]. Overnight in Stuttgart or nearby.

## Day 2 Stuttgart Marianske Lazne Prague

It offers natural mineral springs, magnificent parks and varied architecture. You can also take the sightseeing train at your own expense in the city. Overnight in Prague or nearby. ### Tour Overview

After breakfast, we head to Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic. You'll discover the [Prague Castle](optional), which is a vast historic complex, that was home to the Czech kings and a symbol of the nation's rich history. Visit [Charles Bridge], where you can stroll across and enjoy panoramic views of the city and the river. Next, go to [Old Town Square], the heart of Prague's historic center, where you'll find the famous [Prague Astronomical Clock]. Continue your exploration with a visit to [Old Town City Hall], [Wenceslas Square] and [National Museum]. Overnight stay in Prague or nearby.

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia. Visit the Castle District, including the Trinity Church, Michael's Gate, and the Commercial Pedestrian Street. Explore Main Square, St. Martin's Cathedral, and Dog's Bar, among other highlights. Bratislava Castle offers panoramic views of the city, while [Trinity Church] is a peaceful baroque gem. [Michael's Gate] is the oldest preserved gate in the city, and the [Commercial Pedestrian Street] is perfect for strolling through quaint shops and cafes. [Main Square] features historical architecture, and [St. Martin's Cathedral] is known for its stunning Gothic design. Overnight in Budapest or nearby.

## Day 5 Budapest

### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Budapest, the capital of Hungary. We'll visit the [Fisherman's Bastion], an iconic terrace offering panoramic views of the city. We will also see the [Buda Castle], a former royal residence, and the [Matthias Church], renowned for its stunning architecture and vibrant history. Continue with a visit to the historic landmark [Heroes' Square] and the solemn [Parliament Building]. You can enjoy free sightseeing along the Danube River and the commercial center of Váci Street. Enjoy a scenic [Danube River Cruise](optional, Chinese audioguide is available) to admire the beautiful views along both banks. Overnight in Budapest or nearby.

## Day 6 Budapest Vienna



### Tour Overview

After breakfast, spend the day exploring Vienna. Visit [Schönbrunn Palace] (optional), the imperial summer residence of the Habsburgs, renowned for its beautiful gardens and rich history. Then, continue to the [Stadtpark], [Maria-Theresien-Platz], the historic [Hofburg Palace], [Heldenplatz], [Column of Pest] and [St. Stephen's Cathedral], one of Vienna's most recognizable landmarks. Next, explore the [Vienna State Opera] and [Musikverein (the Golden Hall)] (exterior visit only). In the evening, you have the option to attend a classical concert in Vienna at your own expense. Overnight in Vienna or nearby.

## Day 7 Vienna Salzburg Munich




### Tour Overview

After breakfast, head to Salzburg and visit [Salzburg Fortress], one of the largest and best-preserved castles in Europe; [Getreidegasse (Grain Street)], known for its exquisite cast iron craftsmanship; [Mozart's Birthplace], a museum dedicated to Mozart's life and works; [Residenzplatz], surrounded by the Palace and other historical buildings; and [Salzburg Cathedral], a magnificent Baroque cathedral, famous for its striking architecture and historical significance as the site of Mozart's baptism. Overnight in Munich or nearby.
