[Michael's Gate] is the oldest preserved gate in the city, and the [Commercial Pedestrian Street] is perfect for strolling through quaint shops and cafes. [Main Square] features historical architecture, and [St. Martin's Cathedral] is known for its stunning Gothic design. Over night in Budapest or nearby.

Enjoy a scenic [Danube River Cruise](op tional, Chinese audioguide is available) to admire the beautiful views along both banks. Overnight in Budapest or nearby.
