Day 1 Hamburg Copenhagen Helsingborg



Tour Overview

Depart from Hamburg in the morning, we head to the famous fairy tale city-Copenhagen. Arguably one of Copenhagen's most iconic tourist attractions, [the sculpture of The Little Mermaid] was inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's famous fairy tale. The sculpture is made of bronze and granite and sits in the water at [Langelinie Pier]. Next, you could dive into Denmark's history with a trip to [Amalienborg Palace], the Queen's residence in Copenhagen. The palace consists of four separate rococo palaces around a square. Overnight in Helsingborg or nearby.

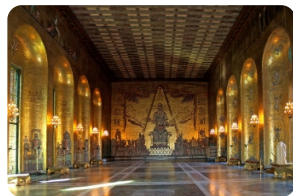


Tour Overview

Explore narrow cobblestone streets, historic buildings, and iconic landmarks. Check out the quaint shops and cosy cafes hidden away in this medieval treasure trove. Overnight on a cruise from Stockholm to Helsinki.

Stockholm Old Town

[Stockholm City Hall]

The Stockholm City Hall was built in 1911 and is located on the shores of Lake Mälaren in the heart of the Swedish capital. It is the image and representative of Stockholm and the office of the city's municipal council.

[Stockholm Old Town]

The history of the Old Town dates back to the 13th century. The city has medieval alleys, round stone streets and ancient buildings, influenced by the North Germanic style. Since Sweden has no wars for 200 years, the old city is relatively well preserved.

Day 3 Helsinki 🚢 Stockholm (overnight in cruise)



Tour Overview

After breakfast, arrive at Helsinki Pier at about 09:55 in the morning. Explore [Senate Square], the famous [Helsinki Cathedral] is also located here. Take a stroll in [Sibelius park] and admire the Sibelius Monument, resembling organ pipes, is made of welded steel with over 600 pipes and with the bust of the composer on one side. Discover the architecture and history of [Temppeliauki Church](optional), Then go to visit [Market Square], the booths here sell traditional market foods and treats, as well as handicrafts and souvenirs. Overnight on a cruise from Helsinki to Stockholm.

[Cathedral Square]

The cathedral is the most famous building in Helsinki, located on the Parliament Square, a Lutheran church. Built in 1852, the Helsinki Cathedral is an exquisite structure with extraordinary ambience and is the essence of Finnish architectural art. On the square in front of the cathedral stands a bronze statue of Tsar Alexander II, built in 1894, to commemorate his extensive autonomy in Finland.

[Underground rock church]

The rock church was carved out of a whole rock. Standing outside the church, it was a huge rock. The roof of the church is supported by 100 radial beams and columns, and is inlaid with clear glass, so you don't feel underground. Because the hall is ring-shaped, the sound is very good, suitable for small bands and a cappella ensemble performances.

[Marina Market]

Here you will find a variety of suede, reindeer skins, crafts made from antlers, colourful fresh fruits and vegetables and flowers that bring inspiration to this calm city. The various flavors of the cuisine on the square give the foodies a reason to visit here!

[Sibelius Park]

Sibelius Park is located in the north-west of the city centre of Helsinki, Finland. The park is green and verdant. In this memorable park, there are two statues, in addition to an abstract figure resembling an organ composed of 600 steel pipes, and a master's head sculpture. These two romantic statues are the works of the famous Finnish female sculptor Eila Hiltunen (born 1922).

Day 4 Stockholm 🚢 Karlstad



Tour Overview

After breakfast, arrive at Stockholm pier at about 9:30. Returning to Stockholm you will have a deeper understanding of the city. Visit the [Vasa Museum] (optional) to see the remarkably well-preserved Vasa warship. Discover Stockholm's royal history by visiting [Stockholm's Royal Palace]. In the heart of the city, embark on a [boat trip] (optional), explore the city from a different perspective. Overnight in Karlstad or nearby.

[Stockholm Royal Palace]

It is the largest royal palace still in use in the world. In the palace you can visit a variety of gold and silver jewellery, exquisite utensils, and exquisite murals and reliefs in the palace. In addition, the guard changing ceremony in front of the palace has become one of the famous tourist attractions.

[Vasa Shipwreck Museum]

The 17th century battleship - Vasa, which was picked up from the sea floor, was displayed in the pavilion. Although the history of sailing is very short, the Swedes are still regarded as national treasures, because they present the technology and art of Swedish shipbuilding in the seventeenth century, especially the wood carving skills on board are still very exciting.

Day 5 Karlstad  Oslo  Gothenburg



Tour Overview

After breakfast, we will cross the border into Oslo, the capital of Norway. Start in [The Vigeland Park], where you can wander among different sculptures. Make your way down towards [Oslo City Hall], with its two characteristic red brick towers, it's full of impressive artwork and commissions by famous artists, both inside and outside the building. Visit [Akershus Fortress] overlooking the fjord, and experience a piece of Oslo history which has been at the site for almost 700 years. Overnight in Gothenburg or nearby.

[Vigeland Sculpture Park]

The Vigeland Sculpture Park is named after the famous sculptor Gustav Vigeland, which has 192 sculptures and a total of 650 statues. The central idea of all the statues in the Welland Sculpture Park focuses on a theme - "life", which shows people from birth to death, giving visitors a lot of life enlightenment, so it is also called "life journey park".

[Oslo City Hall]

The Oslo City Hall is the awarding place for the annual Nobel Peace Prize. From the outside, it looks like a slightly serious government office building, but after entering, the walls of the memorial hall are full of beautiful murals depicting Norwegian history and mythology.

[Akershus Castle]

Akershus Castle is a majestic castle standing on the edge of the Cape Aker. It was designed and built by King Novo V of Norway in 1300 to resist foreign aggression. It is one of the most representative buildings in the Middle Ages. Today, castles are often used to entertain foreign guests. Visitors can experience the history of Oslo here, as well as overlooking the whole of Oslo.
